Know He will guide you in all you do.

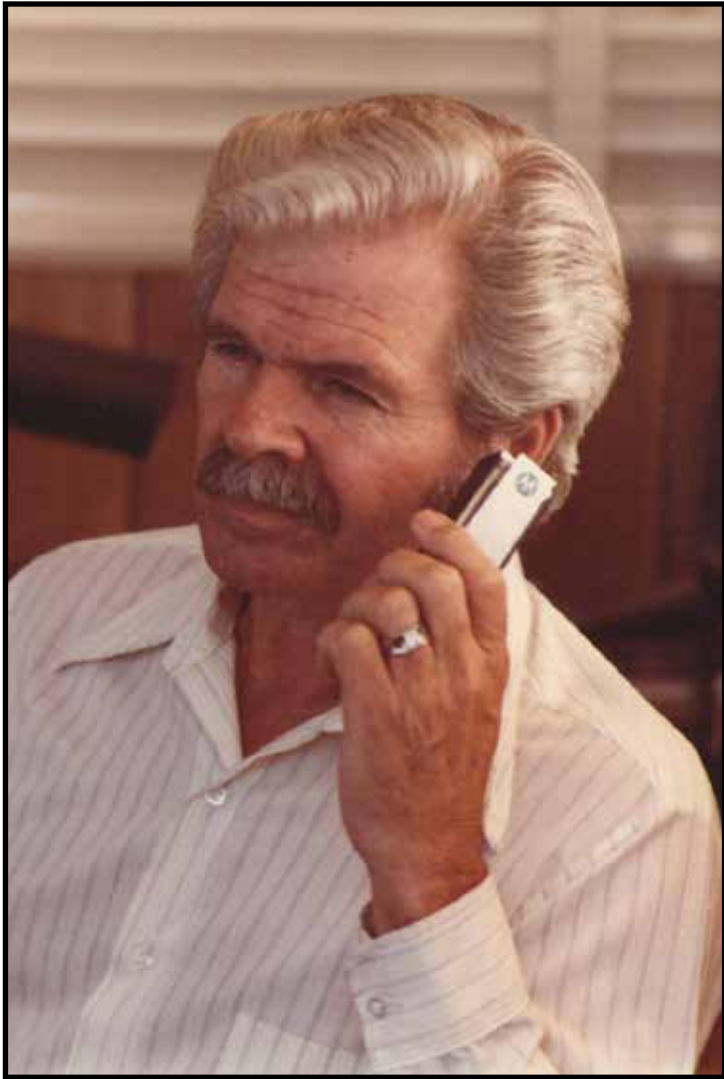
Go now in love, and show you believe.

Go now in peace, in faith, and in love.

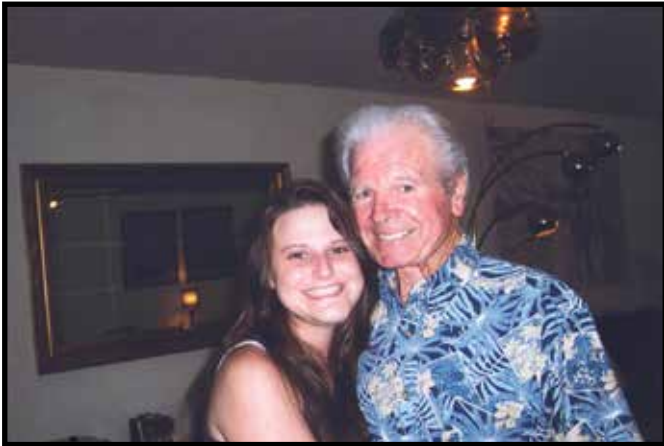
