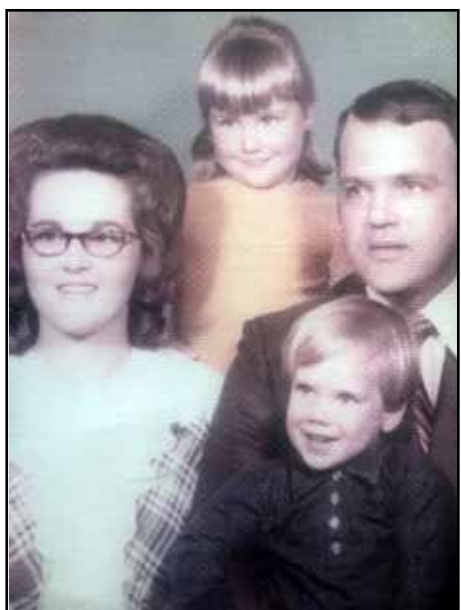
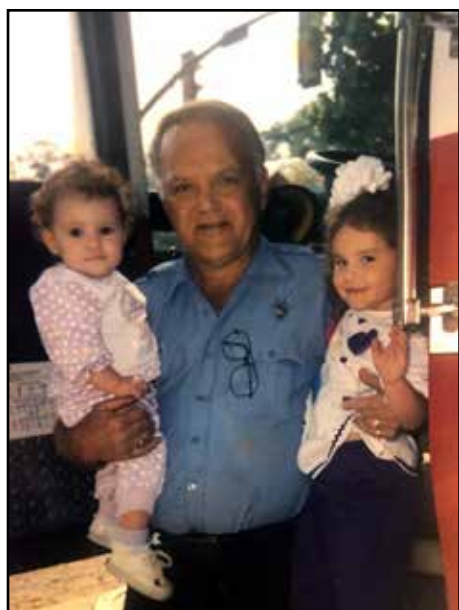

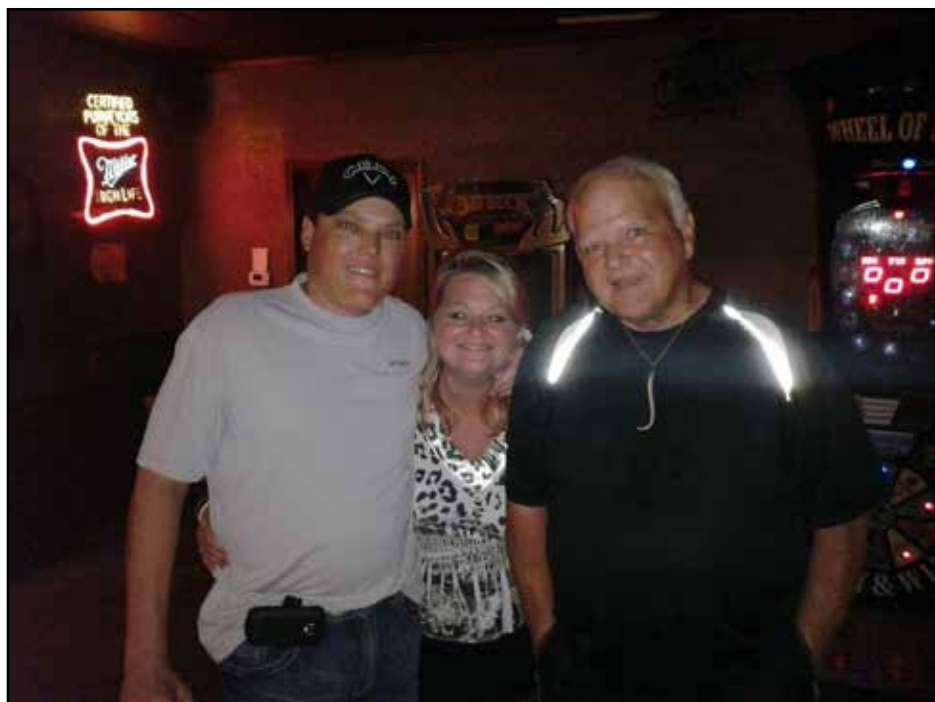
Brice enjoyed his many friends and family on a regular basis, whether that was on a golf course or at the poker table. His family meant the most to him and family time was a must.
