The rivers of God will not run dry!

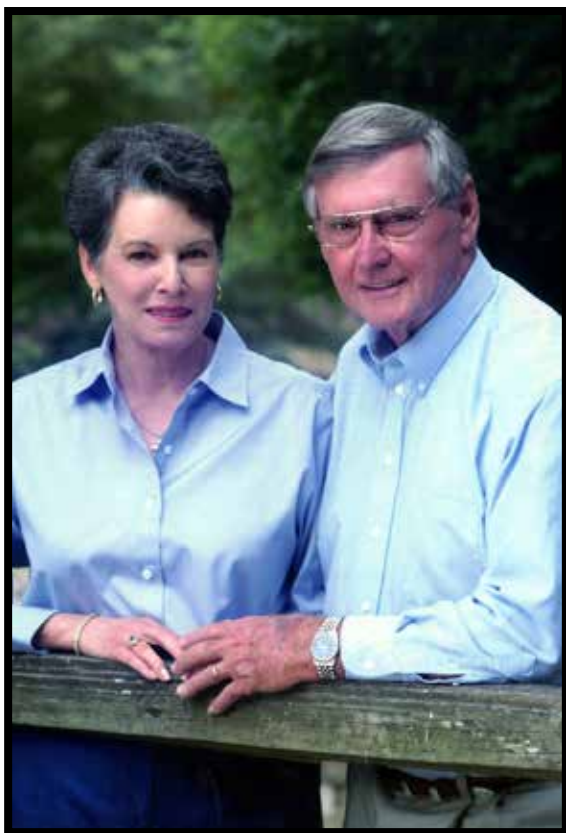
He prepares the earth for His abundant rain.
