Stella "Louise" Troy, 93, of Beaumont, died Tuesday, May 9, 2017.

Louise was born on March 11, 1924, in Thomas, West Virginia, the middle daughter of three girls, to Mable and Duncan Shaffer.

She moved with her family to Port Arthur in 1937 from Franklin, Pennsylvania, and graduated from Thomas Jefferson High School in Port Arthur in 1941. Upon graduation from TJHS, Louise went to work for the Texas Company (now Texaco) in Port Arthur. After working

for Durham Business College and then Jefferson County Judge Chester Young, she retired from the Texas Department of Human Resources in 1989. Louise was a long-time member of Beaumont Community Partners and especially active with The Rainbow Room for foster children.

She was a member of First United Methodist Church of Beaumont for fifty-nine years, where she served on numerous committees, taught Sunday school and was a proud member of the United Methodist Women. She also was an active member of Church Women United of Beaumont.

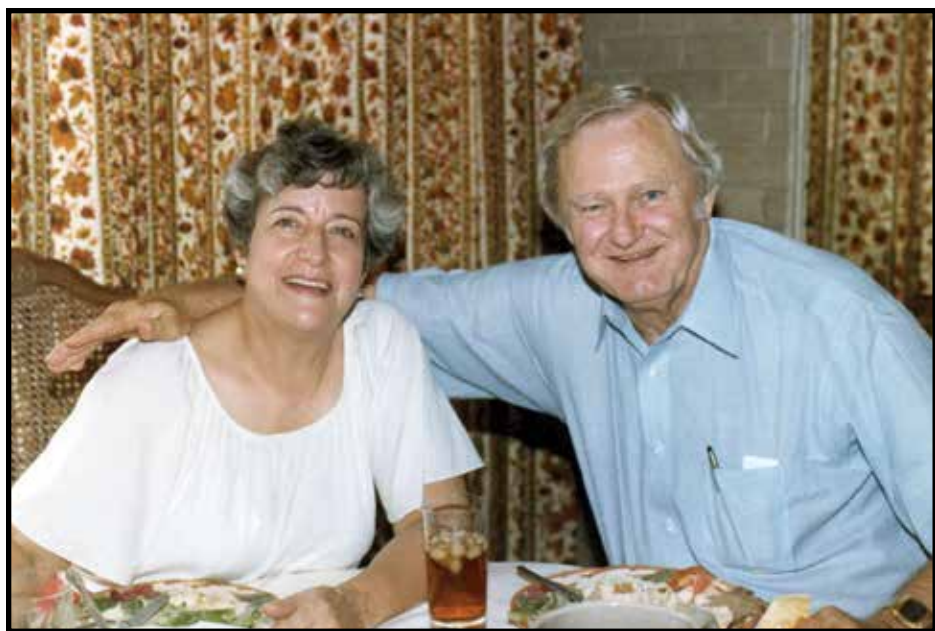
