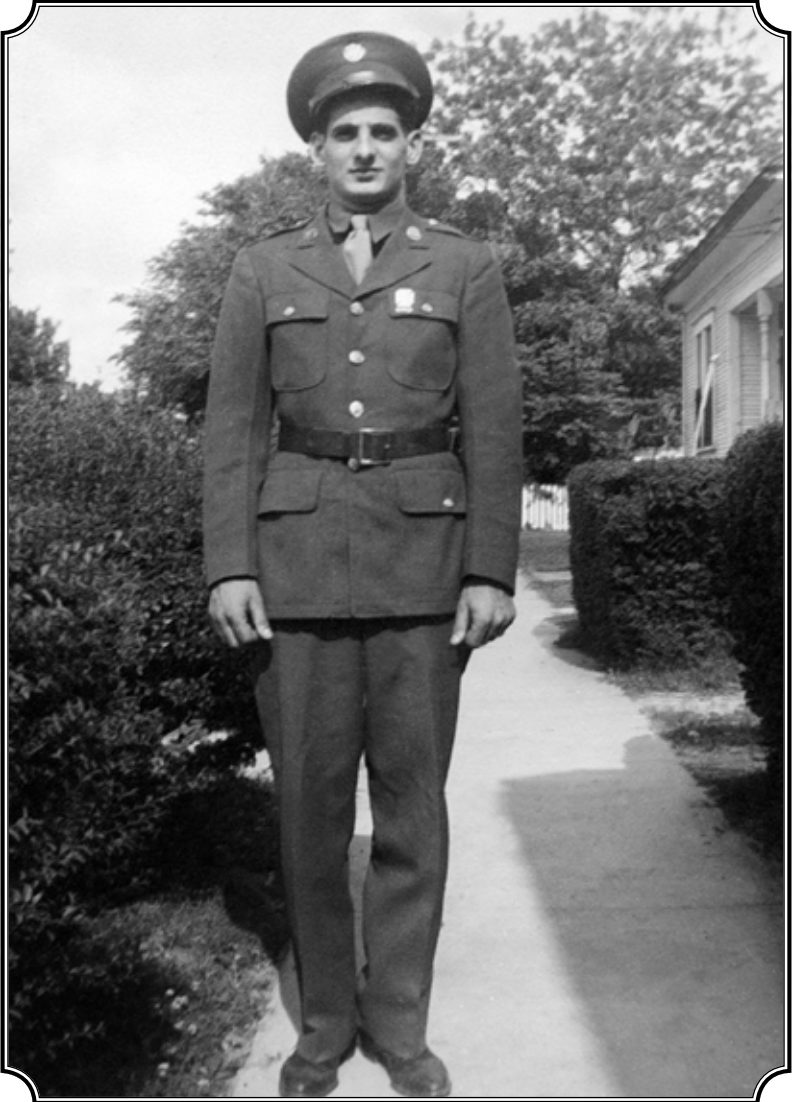

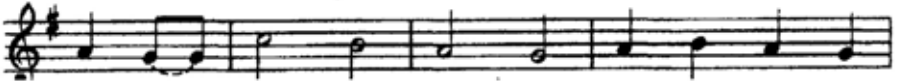

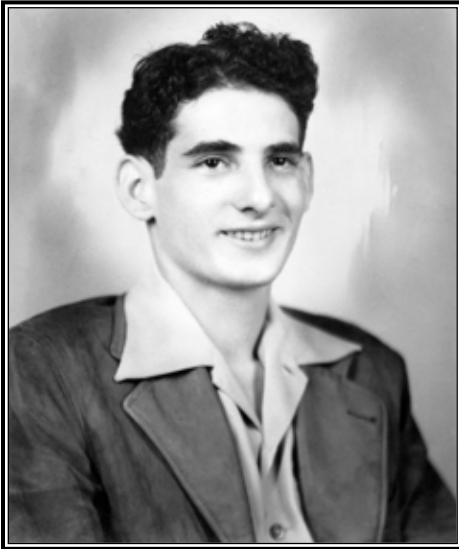

Dominick is preceded in death by his wife, Dorothy Patricia Tuminello; and his parents.













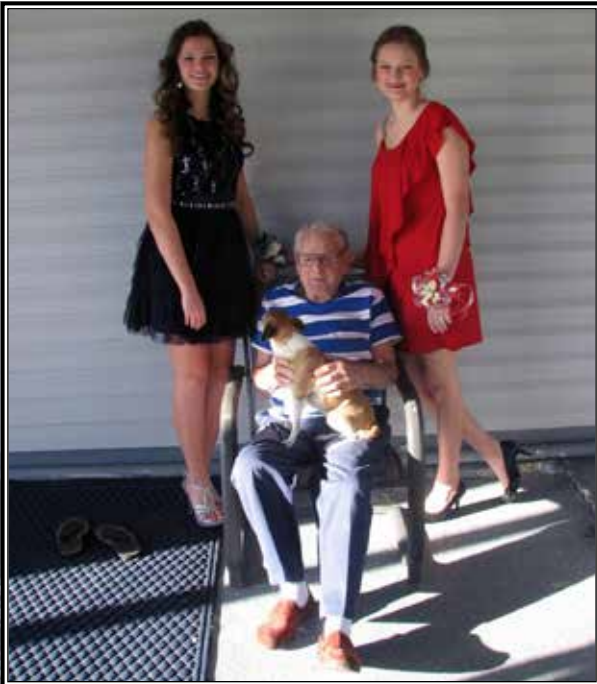
