The family would like to extend a special thanks to Dupuis Hospital, Dr. Earle Thornhill, and the staff.





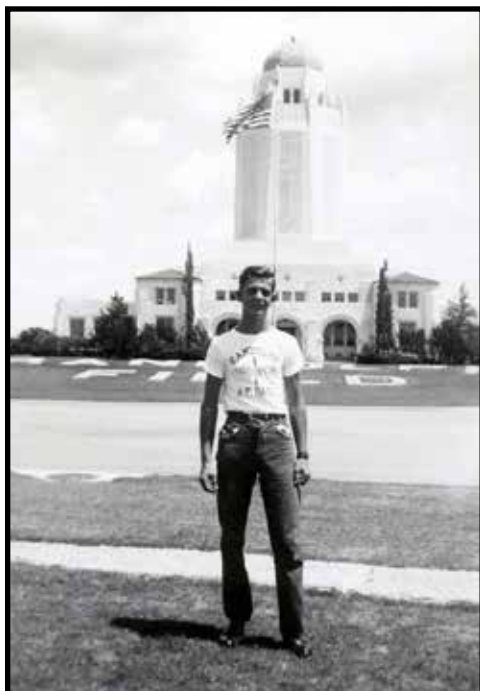
