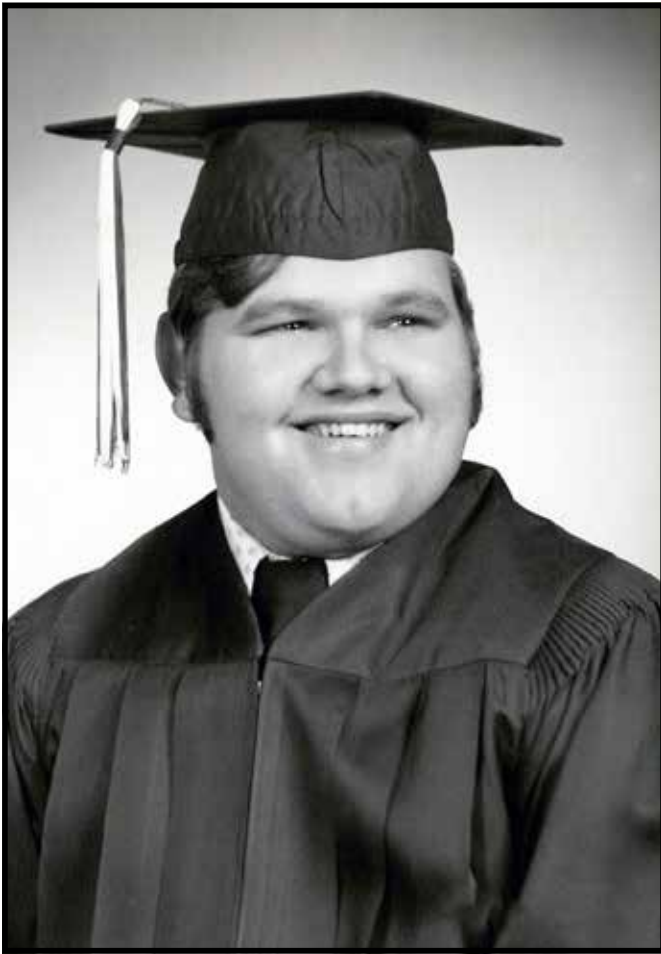

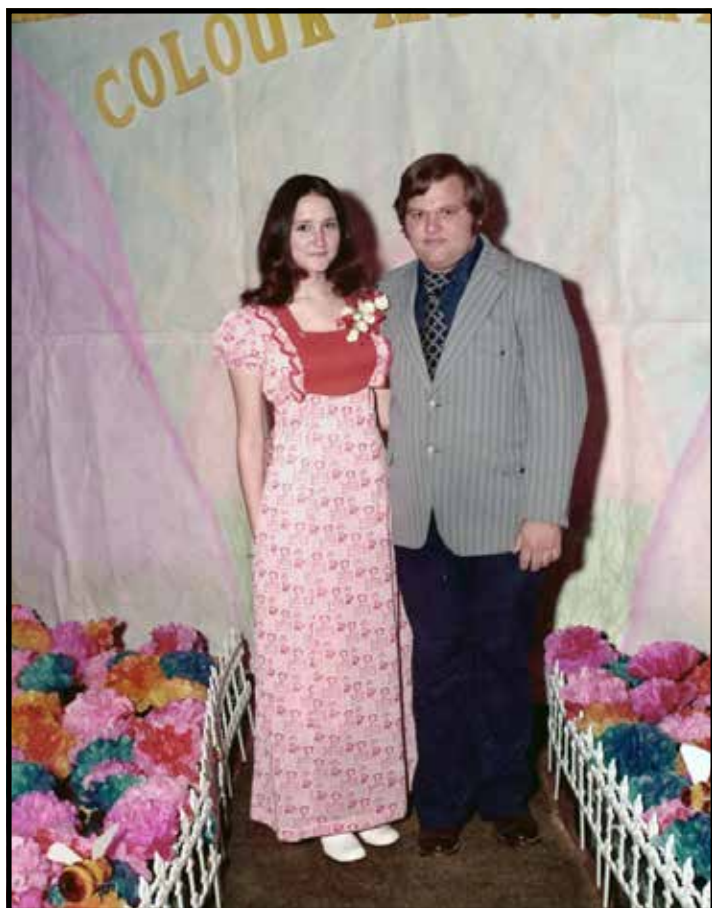

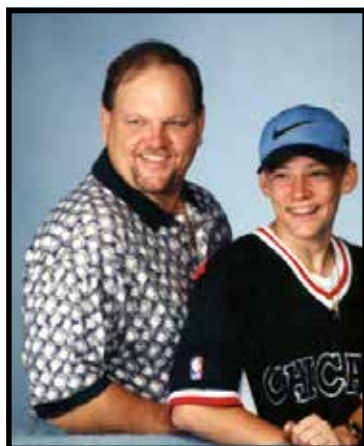
He is preceded in death by his parents; and daughter, Michelle Jewel Wagner.
