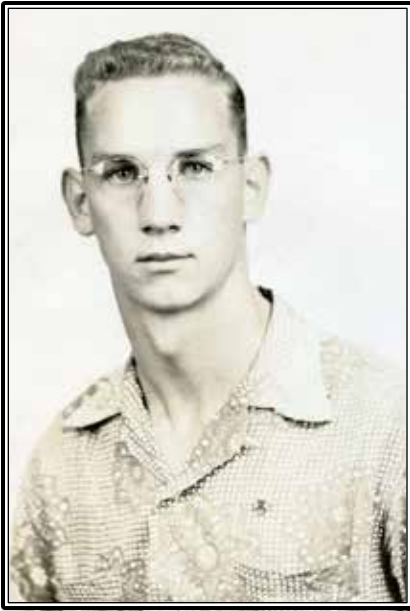




Charles Herbert Wales

Charles was a proud “Greenie” graduating from South Park High School in 1952. He won a scholarship to play basketball and run track and Lamar State College, where he was a member of

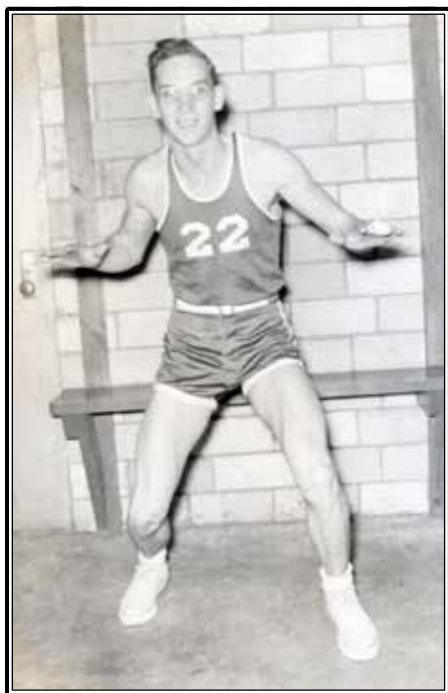

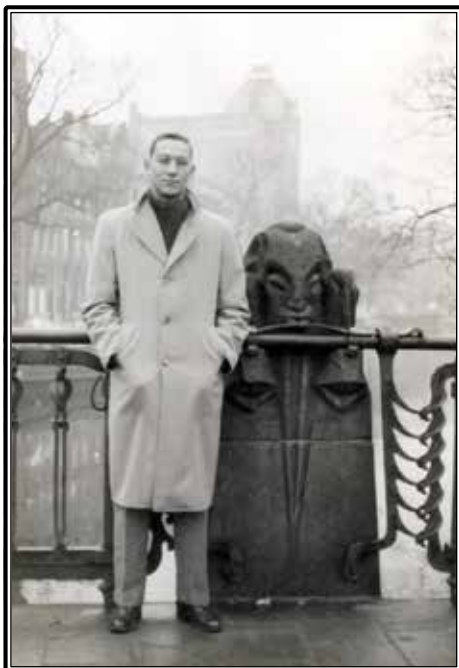
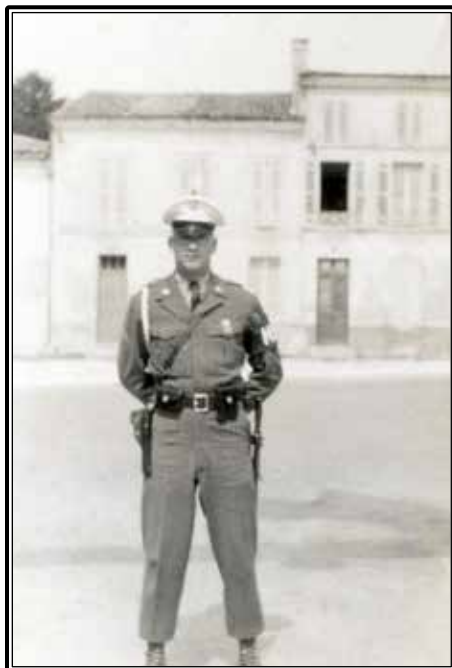
He is preceded in death by his parents; and brothers, Jim Wales and Clyde Roye; and sister, Sybil Hayden.
