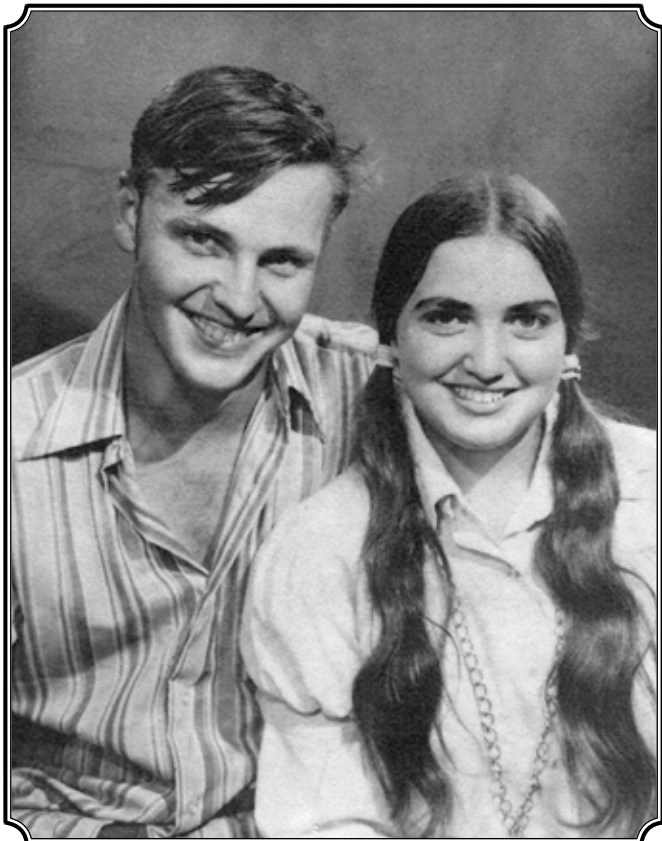

Husband in Heaven

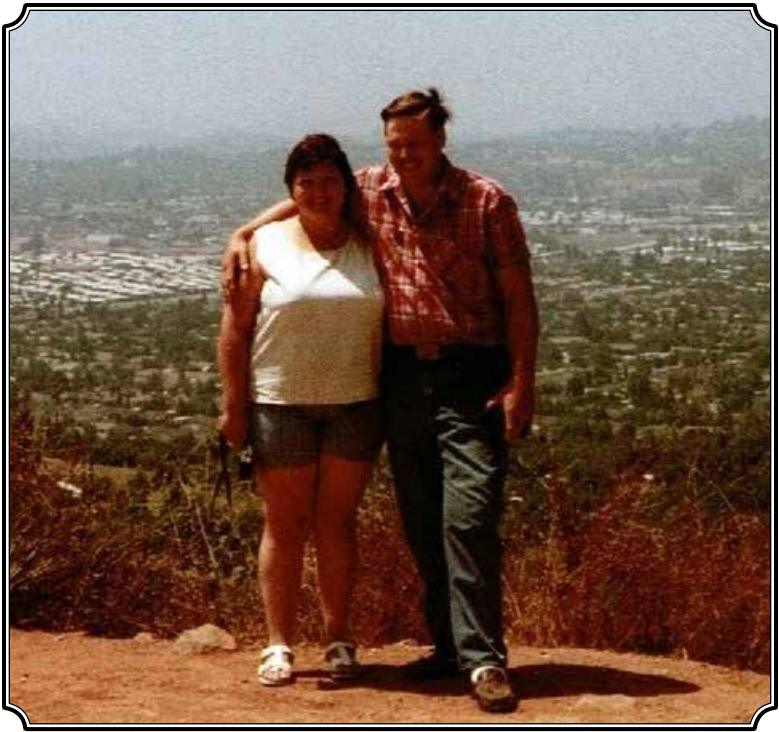
*Although you sleep in Heaven now
