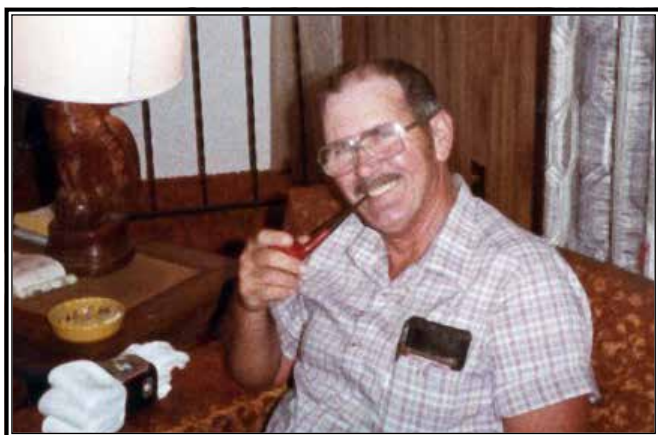
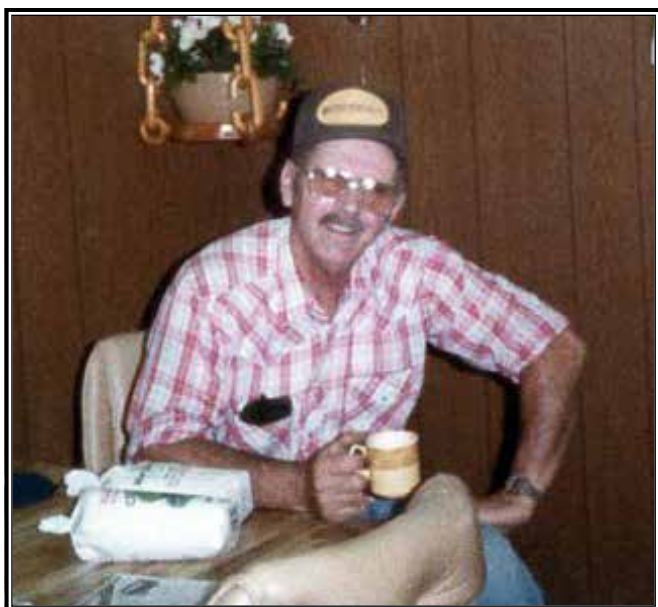
Paul is a retired construction superintendent from Neid Construction - Development Corp., and Mae is a homemaker.

They were married December 19, 1950 in Beaumont. They have 7 grandchildren, and 2 great-grandchildren.









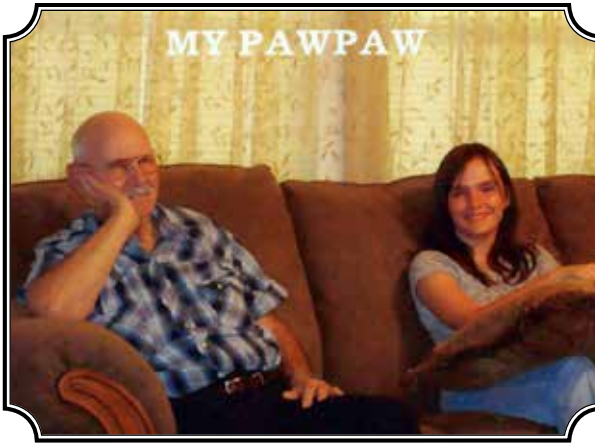
