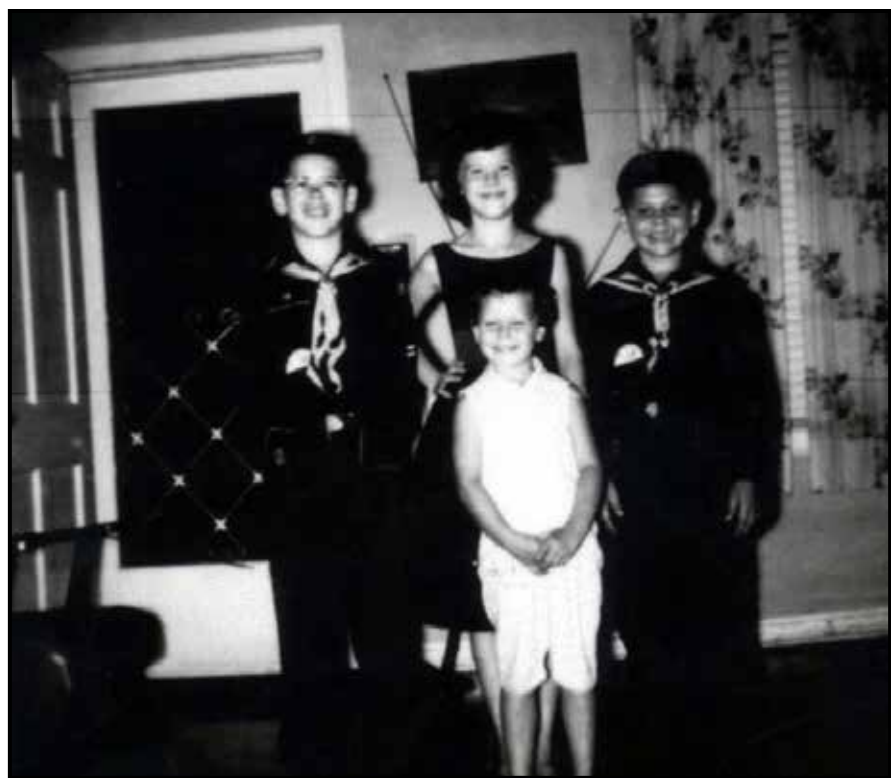


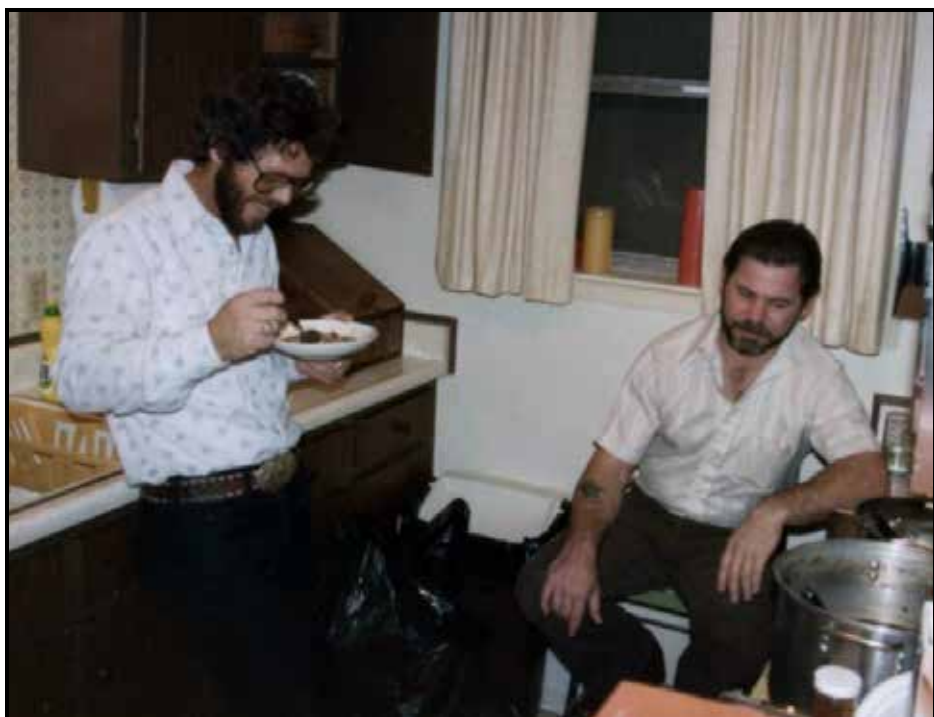

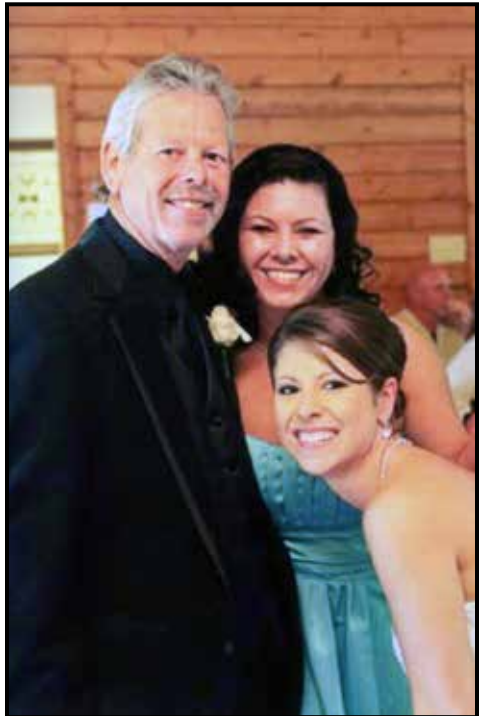

He is preceded in death by his wife, Connie Wiggins; sister, Karen Myers and brother, Tommy Wiggins.



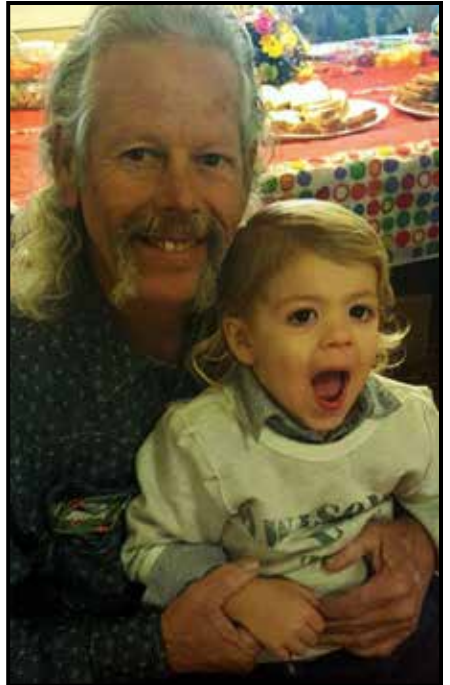
