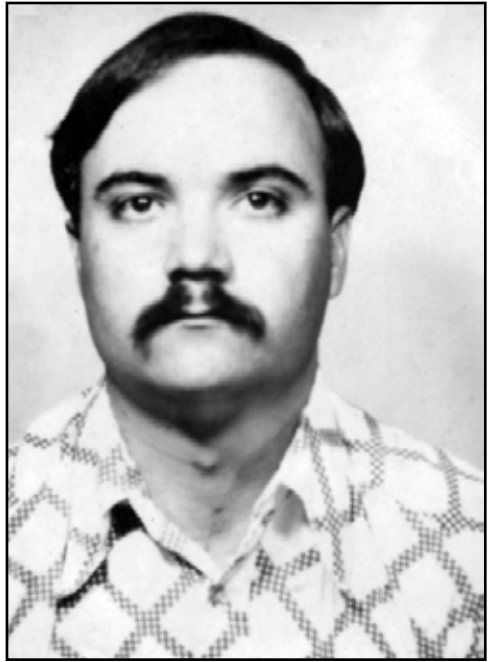


# **Billy Wilcox**

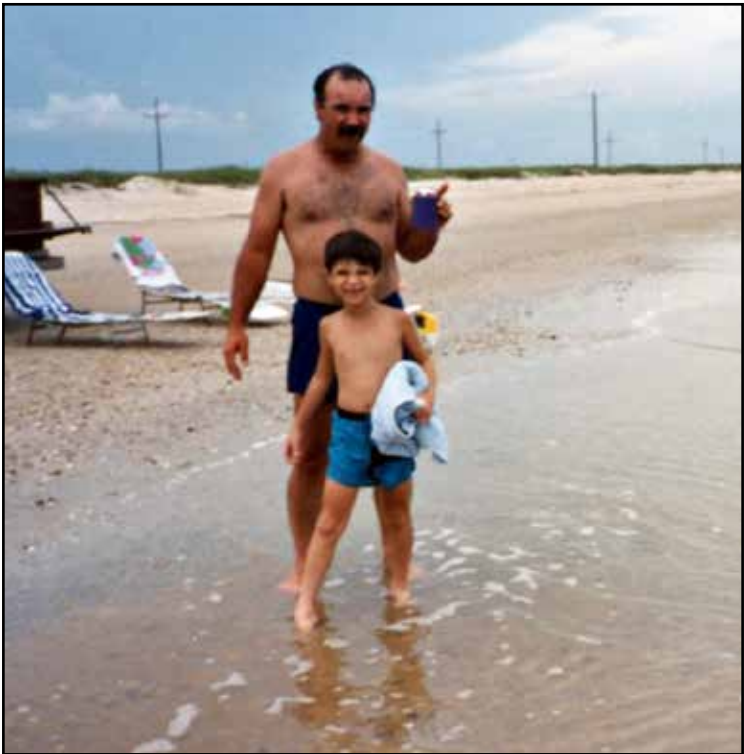


