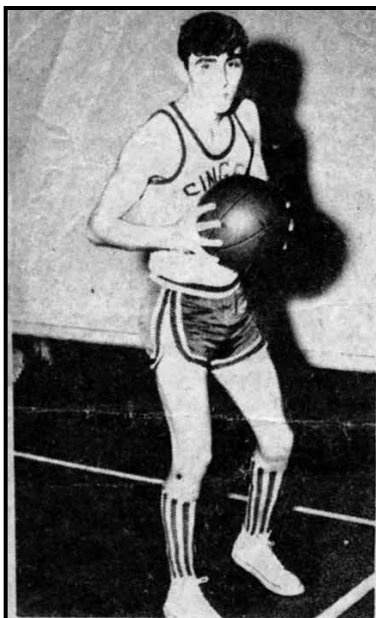

Lettered one year - David has come along real strong in the last 20 ball games. He has been a big part in winning. He played fine ball in the Regional Tournament.



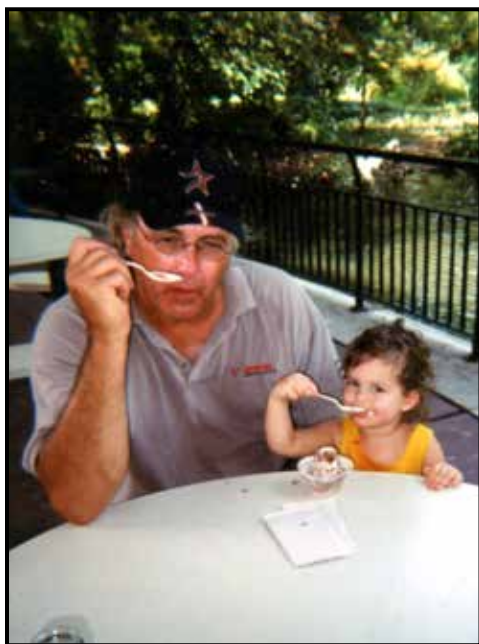
