He is preceded in death by his parents, Rae Mignon Winger and Melvin L. Winger.









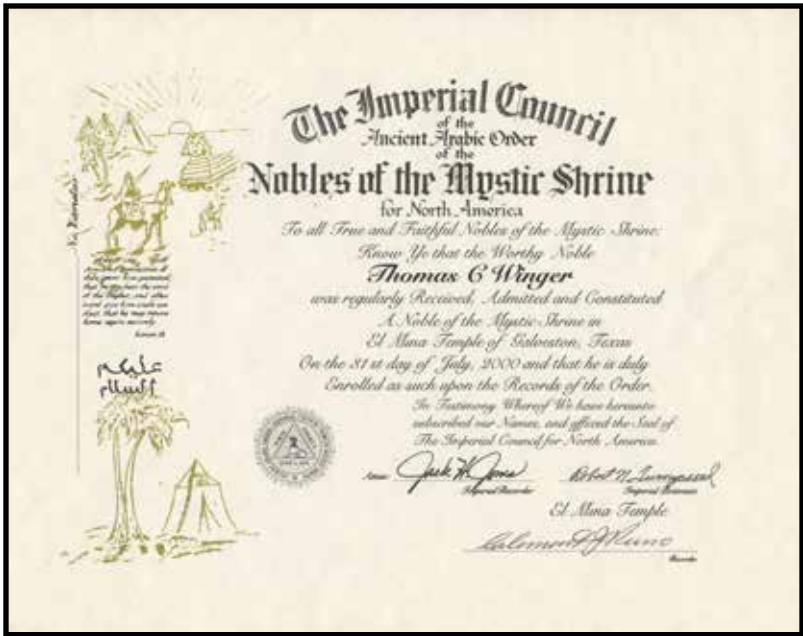
