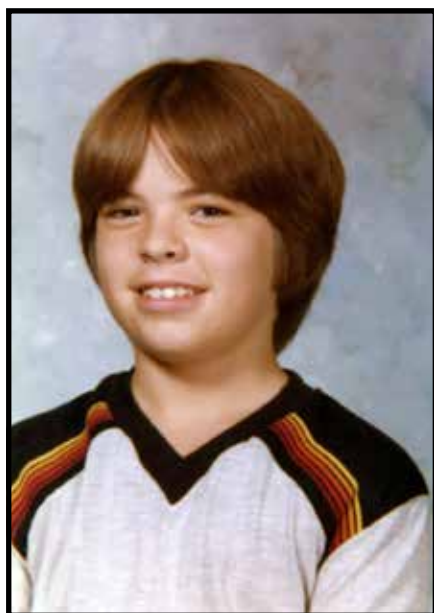

Survivors include her husband, Rayford Wright; son, Dwayne Wright and his wife, Dawn, of Cleveland;

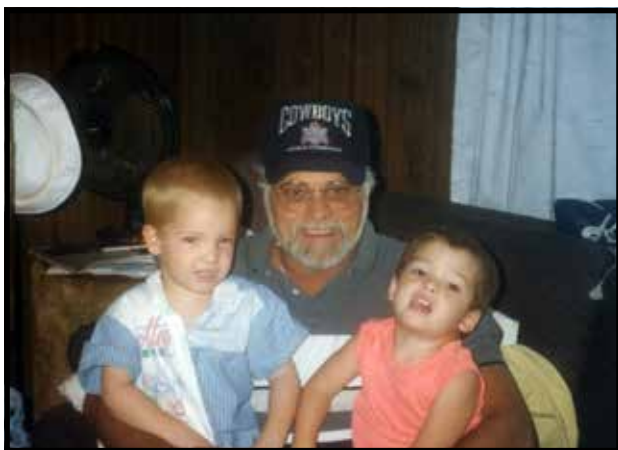

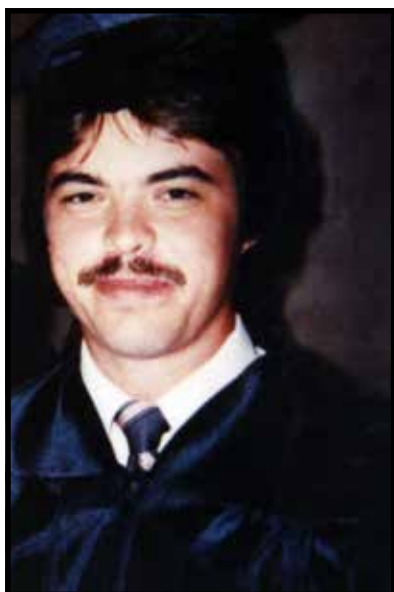

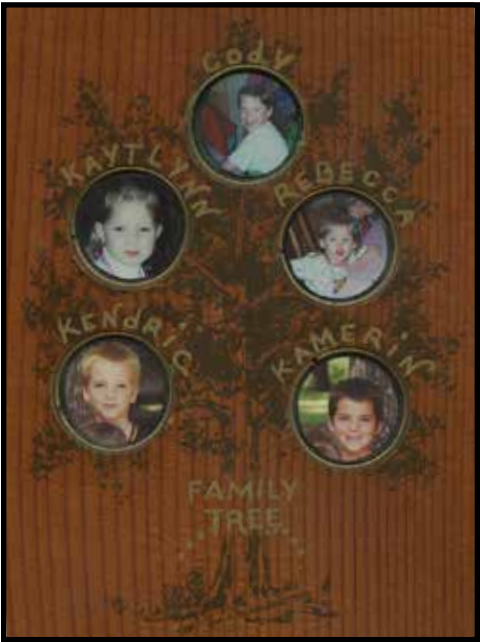
