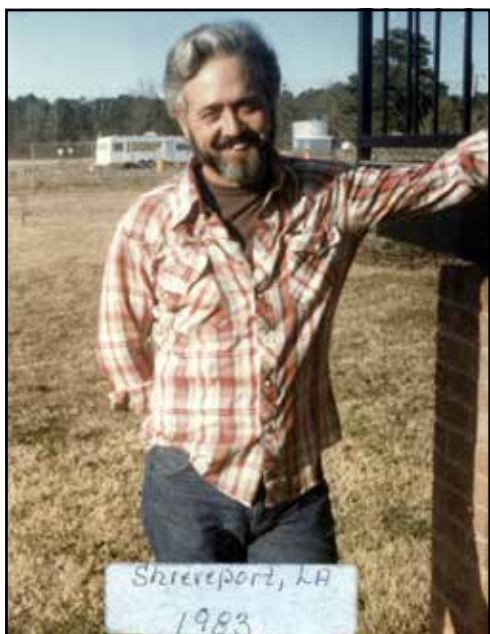
He is preceded in death by his father, Edward Lee Conner; mother, Annie Jean Hill; and brother, Ben William Conner; and his wife, Anne Mae.



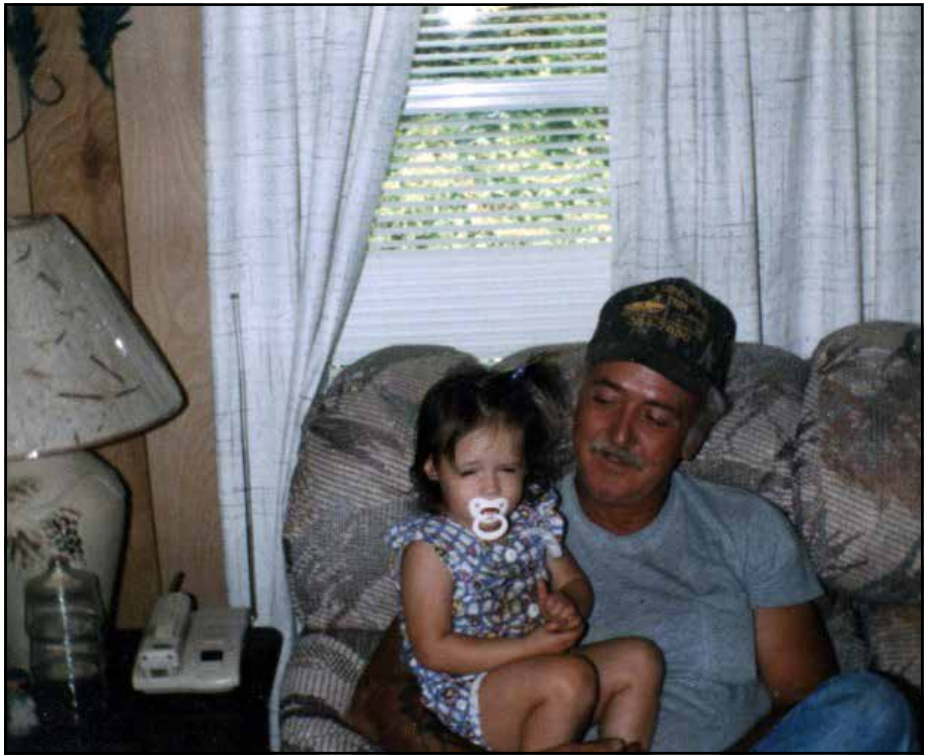


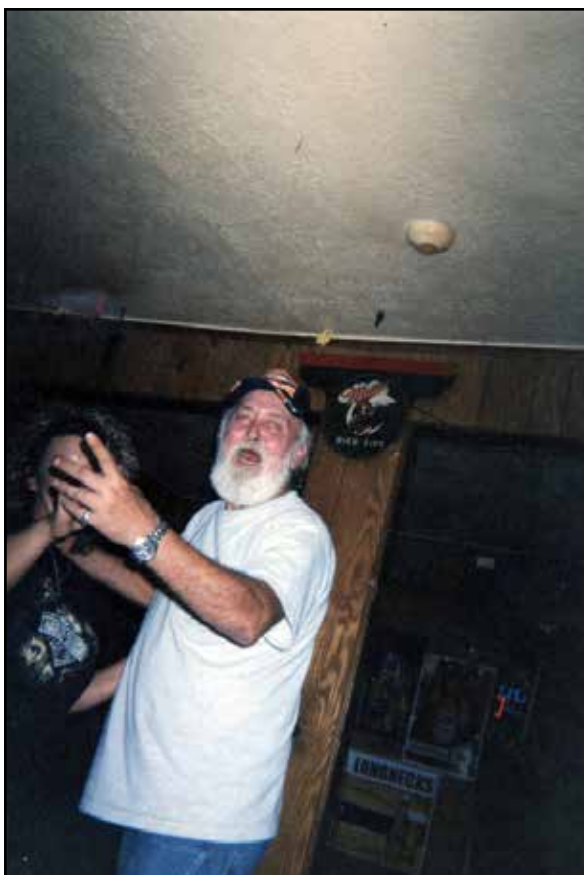
