**Jesus “Jesse” Flores**, 88, of Nederland, passed away Tuesday June 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2020, at The Medical Center of Southeast Texas, Port Arthur. He was born in Port Arthur, Texas on October 10, 1931 to Baltazar and Juanita Flores. He went into the workforce around the age of fifteen and later got his GED. He married the love of his life, Rachel Granado, of Beaumont, in 1952; they were married for sixty-eight years.

He was in the military from 1953-1954, ranked as a Private First Class. While serving, he competed in the
