The family would like to thank Mr. Havens' Silsbee Oaks Family for the loving care given to him.







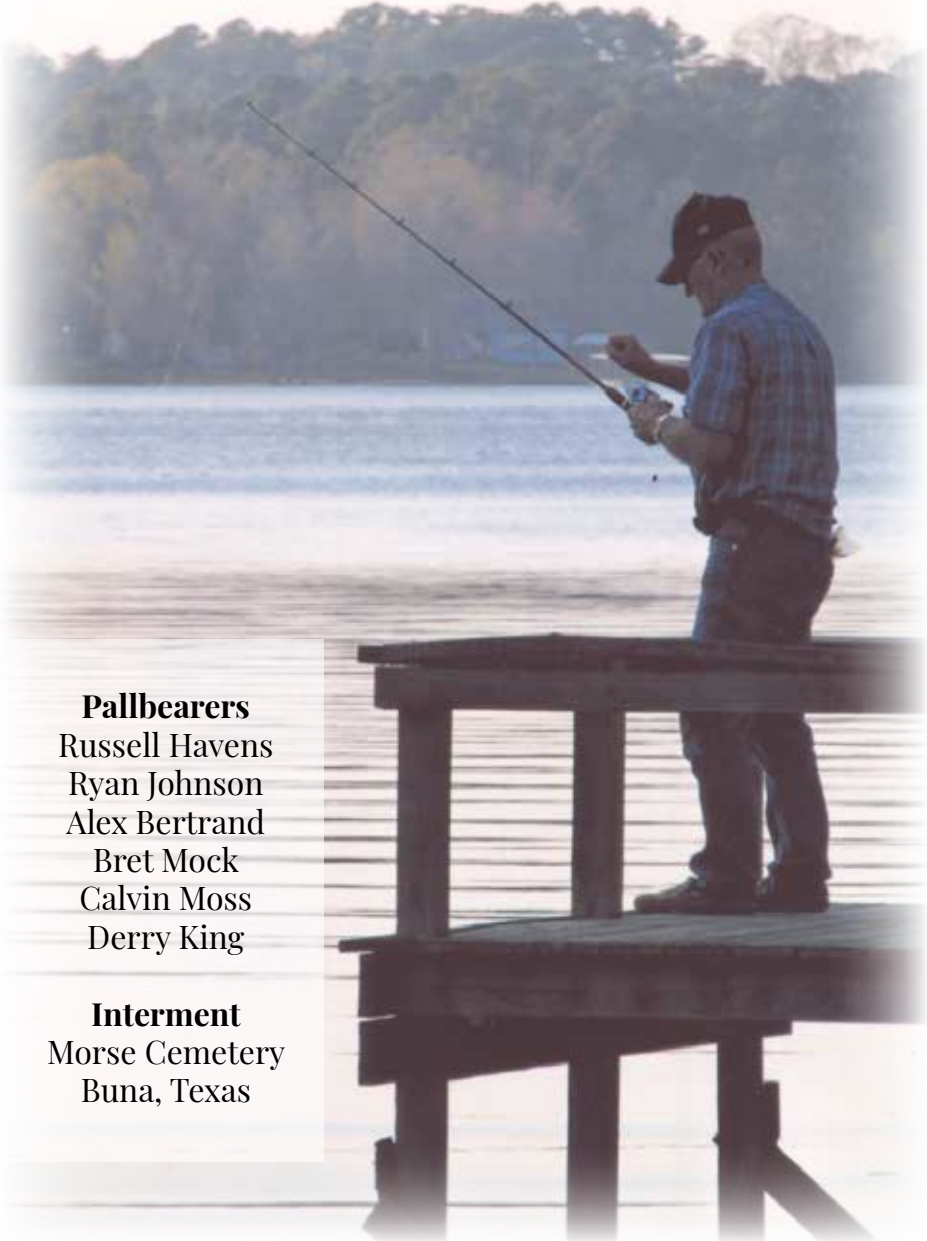
