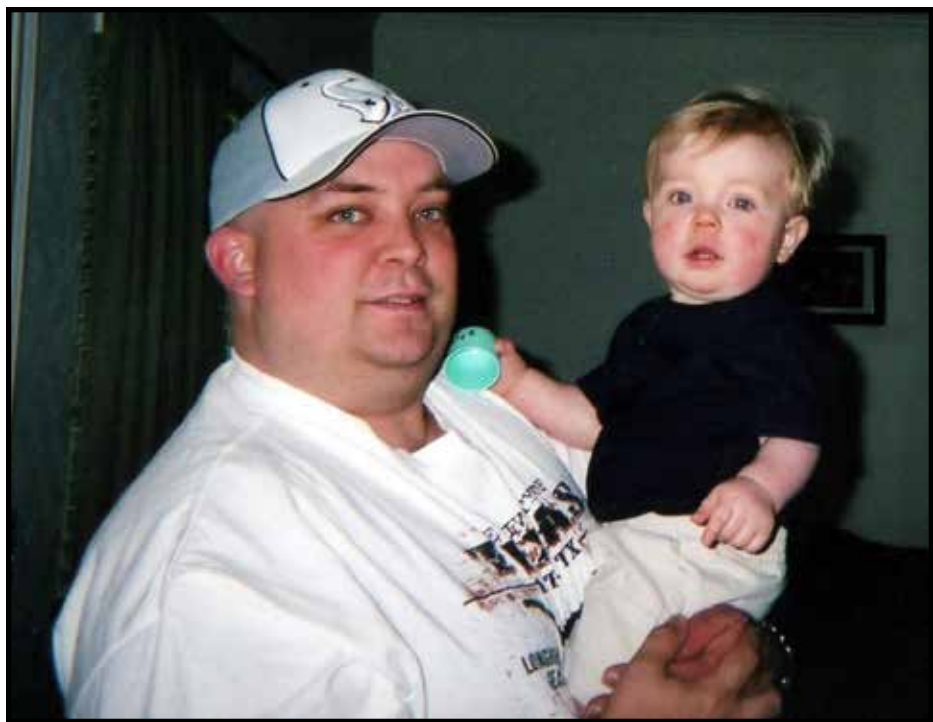




















### *I've Gone Fishin'*
