**William “Randy” Randall Hollier,** age 75, peacefully passed away on August 23, 2020, in Beaumont, Texas.

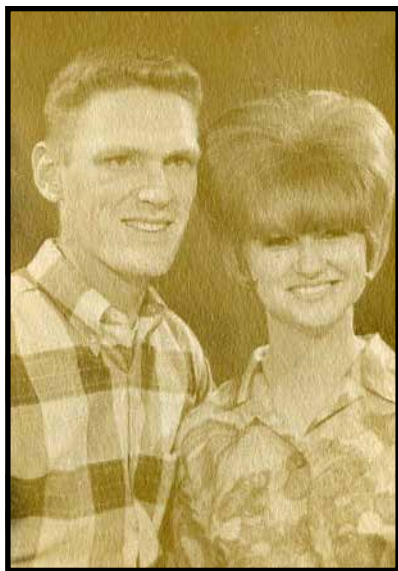
