at the very lowest and saddest times in her life.

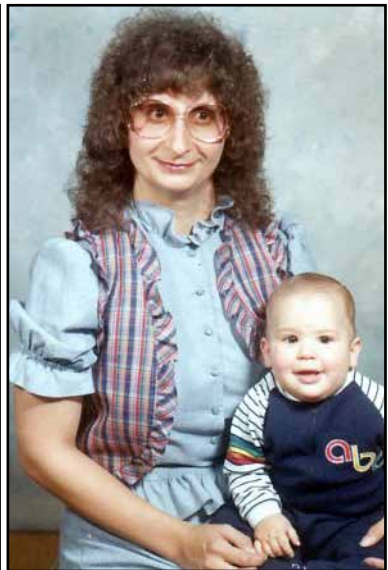
This really bothered her and she questioned the Lord about it.
