He is survived by his three of his seven siblings: Boyd Babineaux, Charlene Burnett, and Eve Wagner.





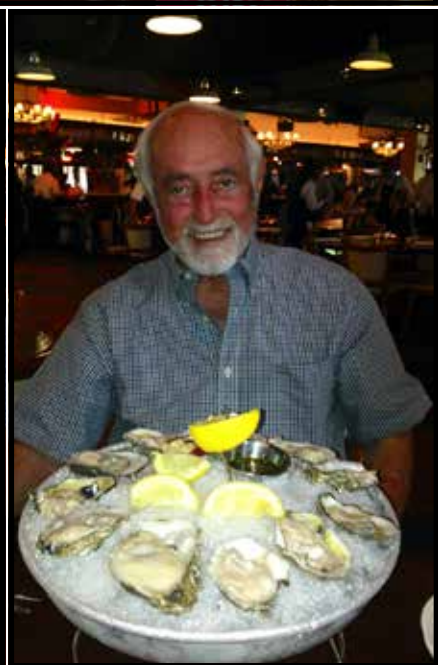
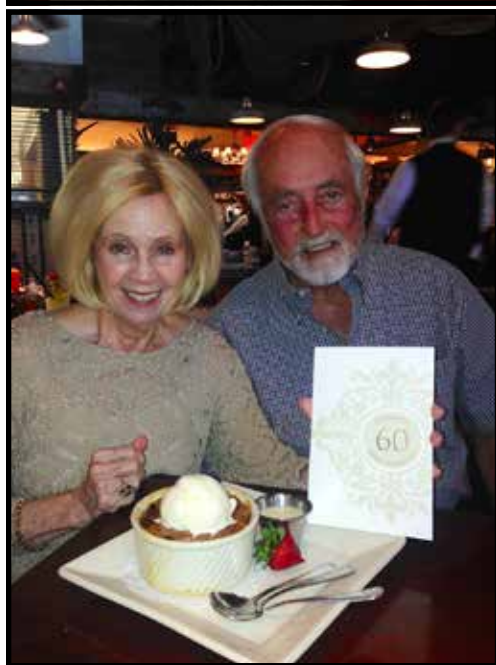
