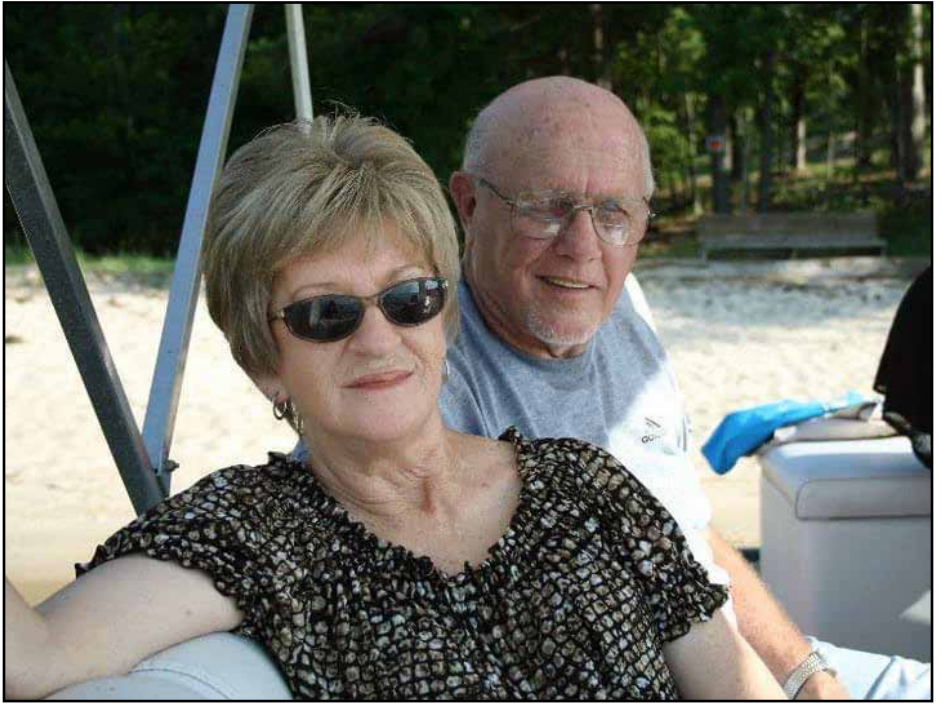

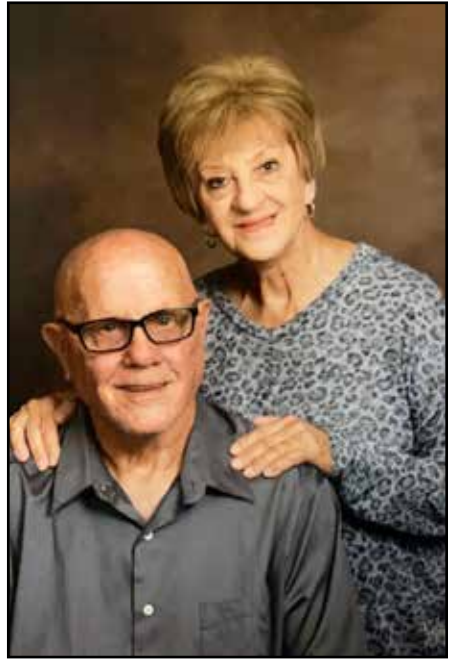
She is preceded in death by her parents and her loving husband, Ronnie.
