She is preceded in death by her husband of twenty-five years, Gene Bergeron and her parents.





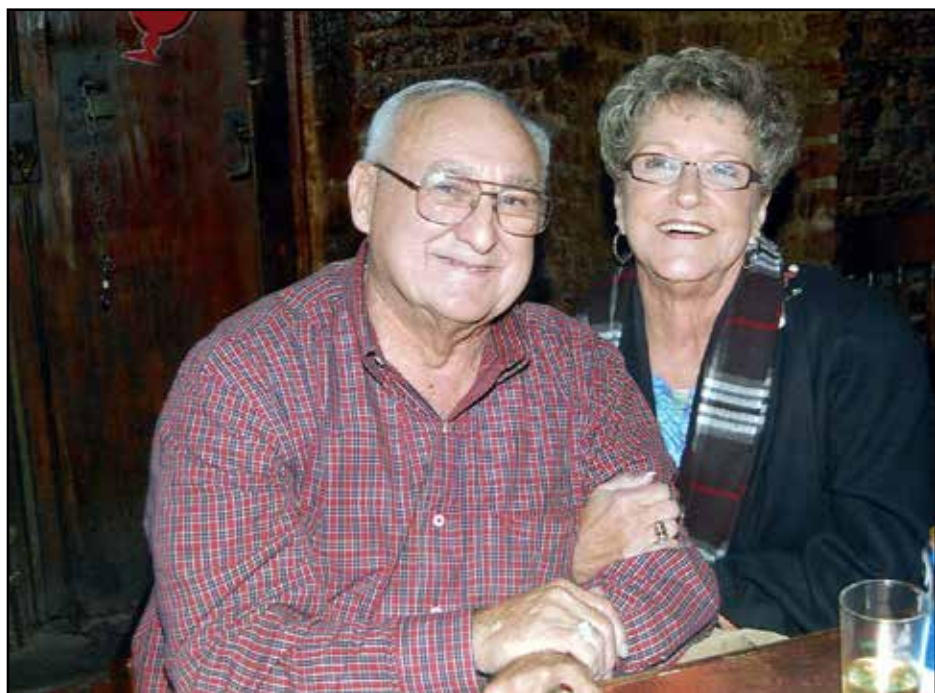








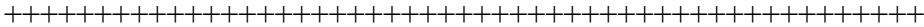




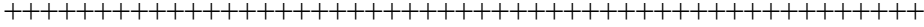
