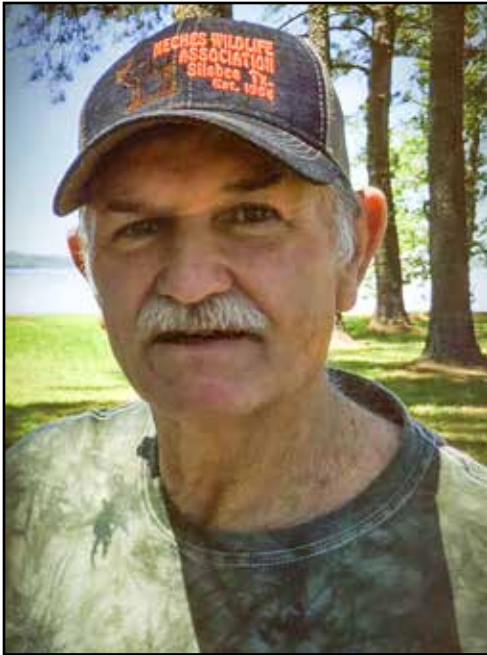

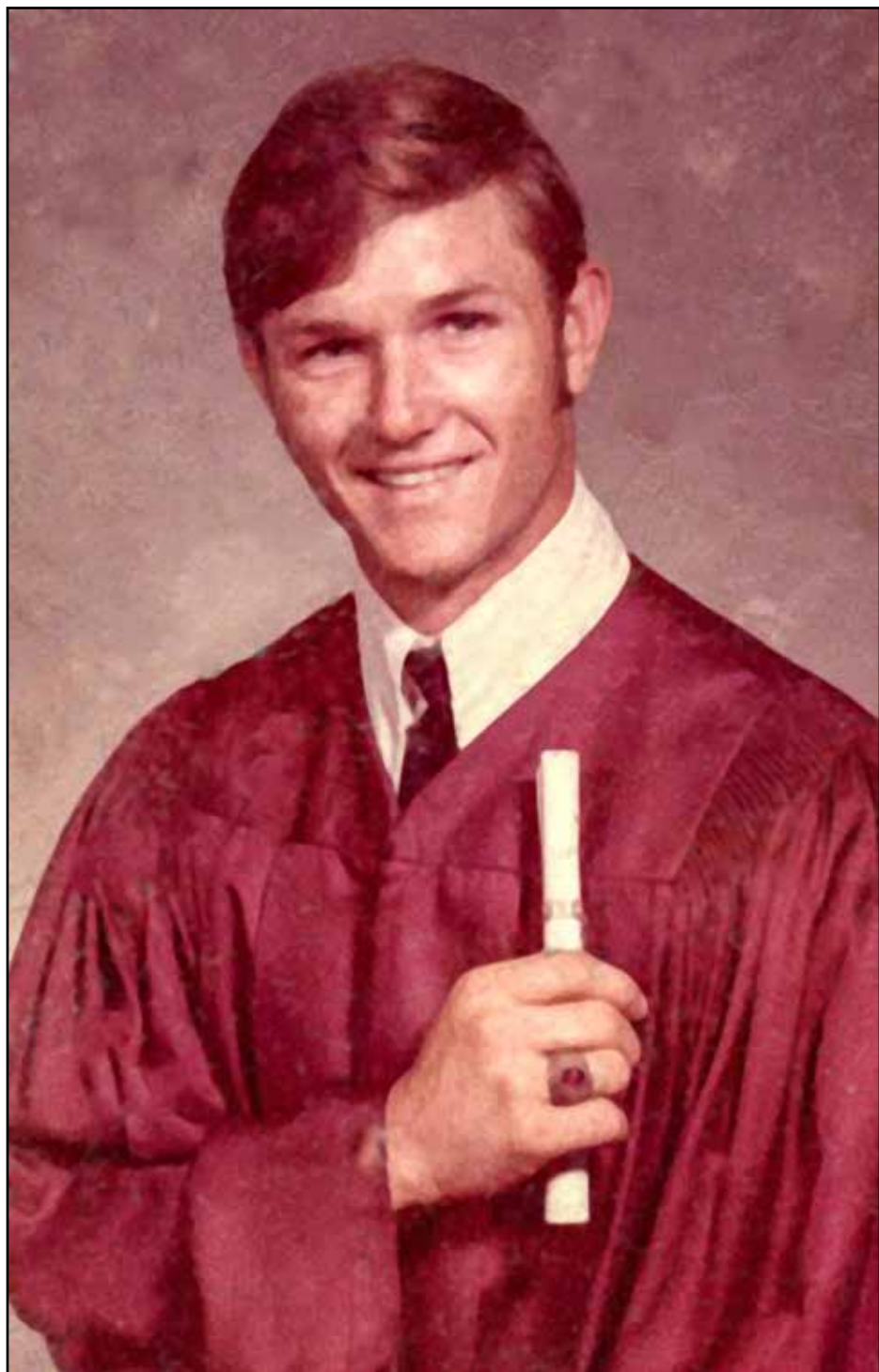

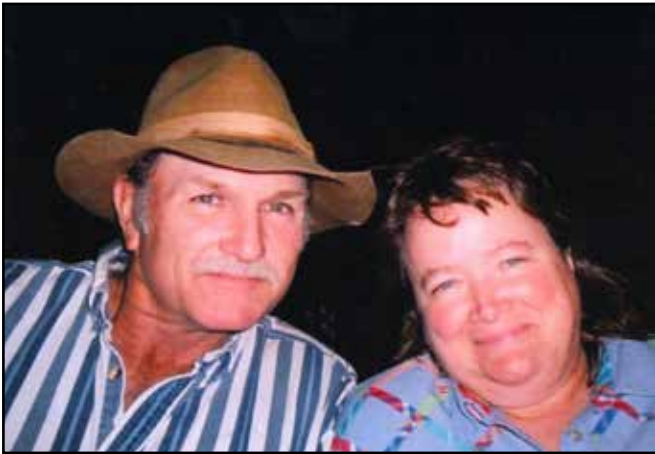
Wayne was an avid fisherman and hunter and enjoyed riding
