She was preceded in death by her parents; husband, S.D. Fontenot; brother and sister-in-law, Elroy and Wanda Henry.





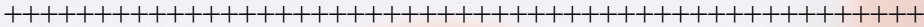




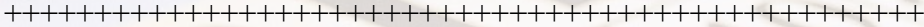
