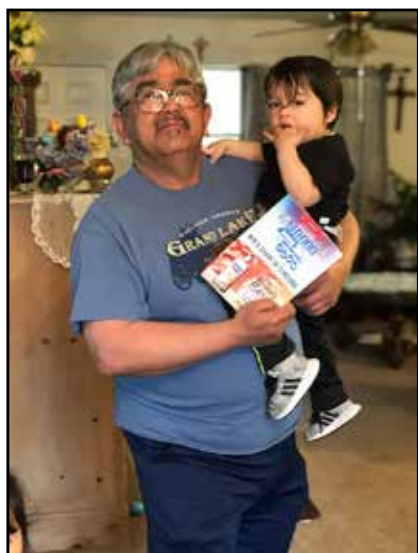
He was preceded in death by his parents; sisters, Leonicia Alviar and Patricia Villafano; and brothers, Gilberto "Bug" and Jose Garcia.

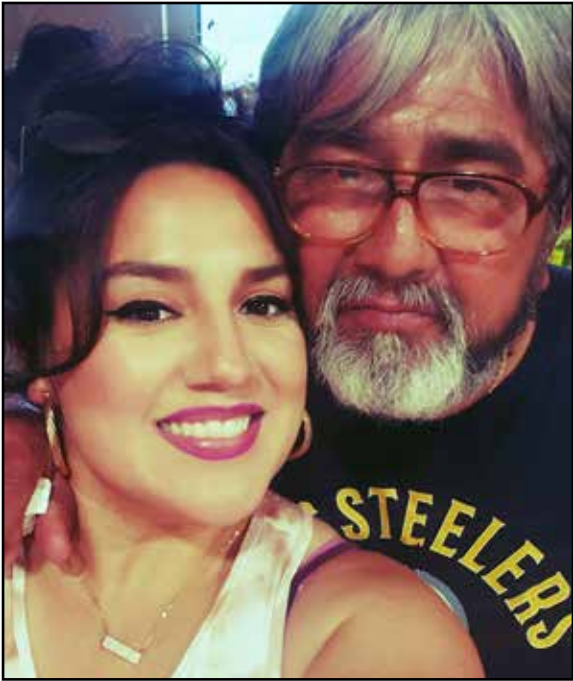


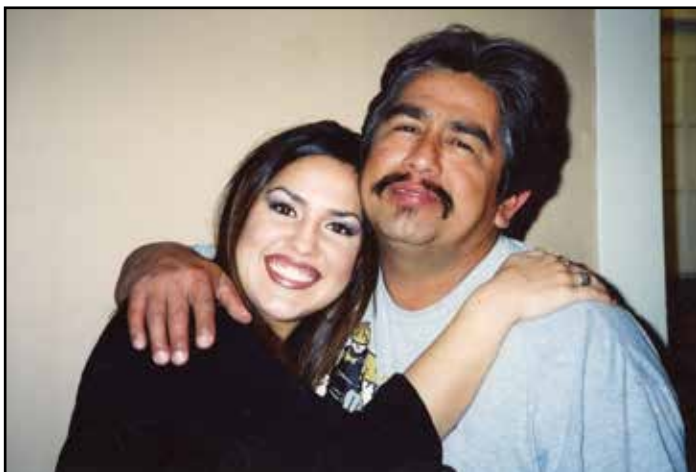


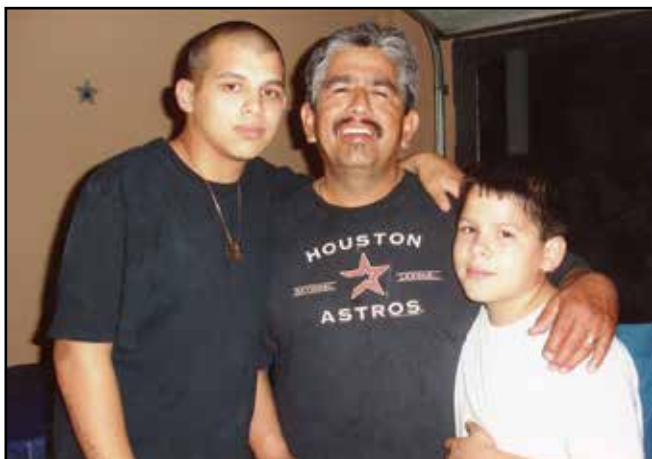
