served in the Nederland City Council and the Economic Development Corporation for over thirty years and was a member of the American Legion for over fifty years.

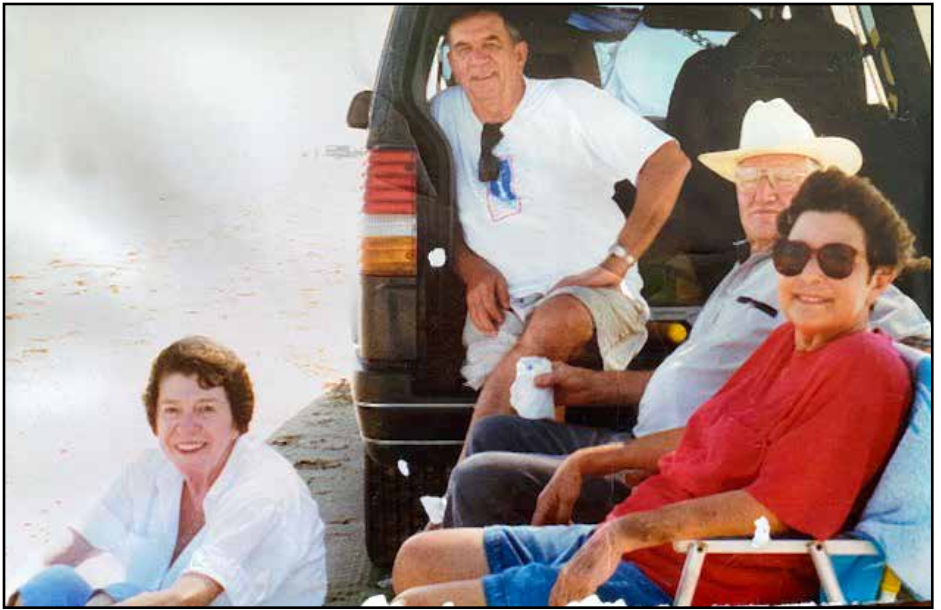
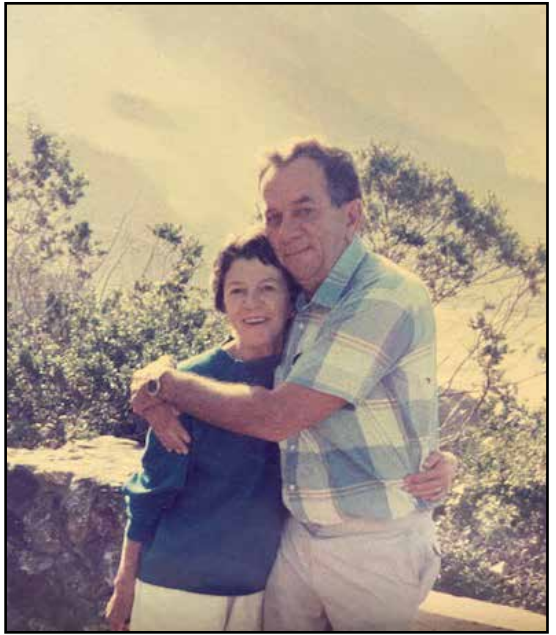
