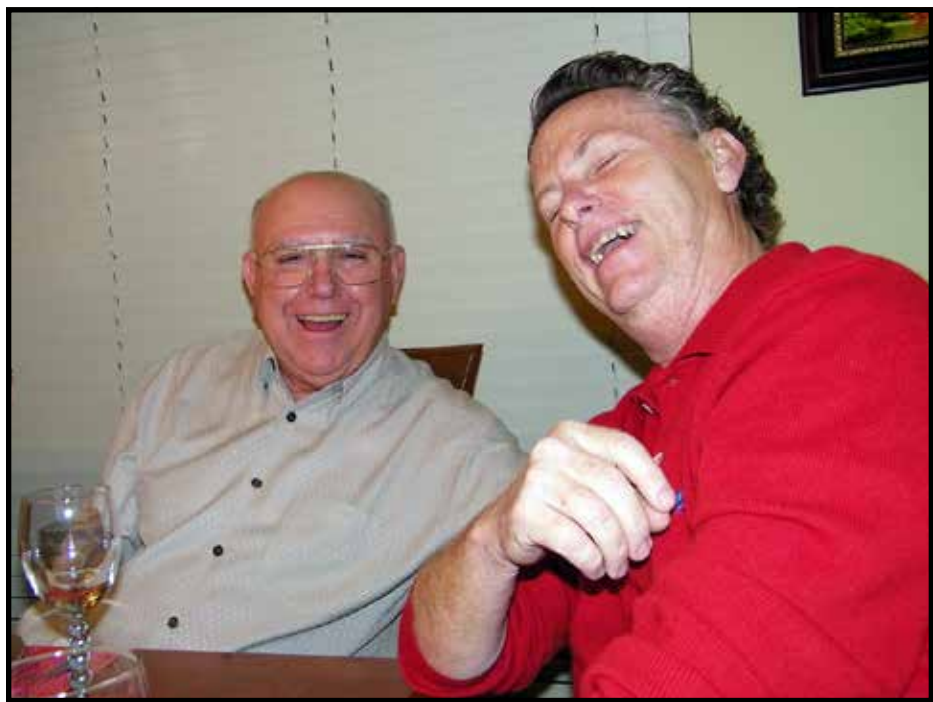

He is preceded in death by his parents and sister, Priscilla Arey.



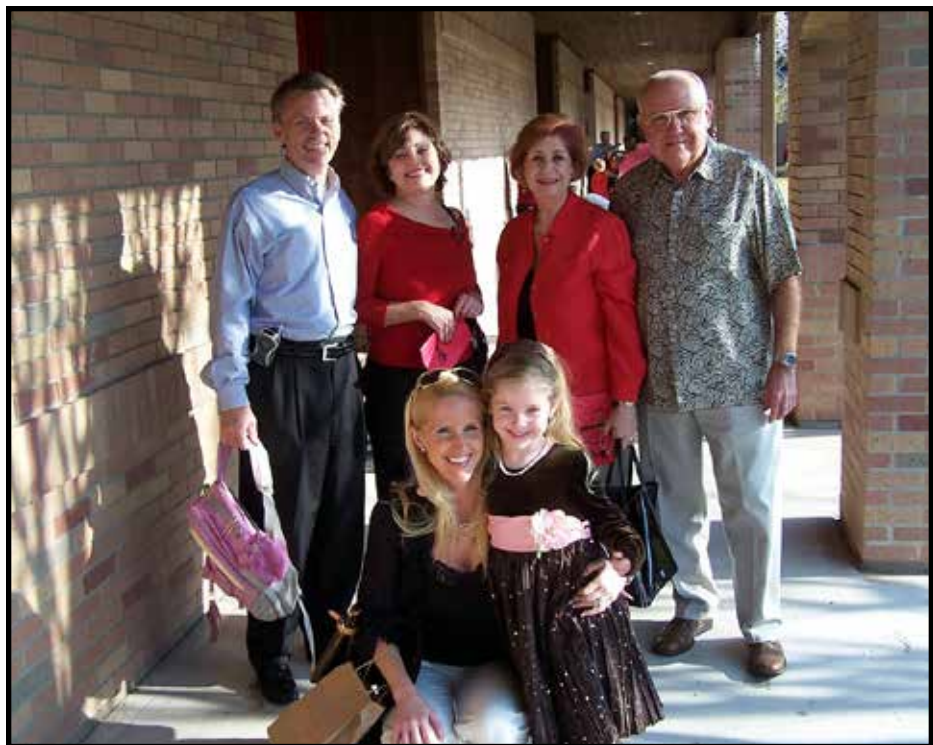
