“A Closer Walk with Thee”

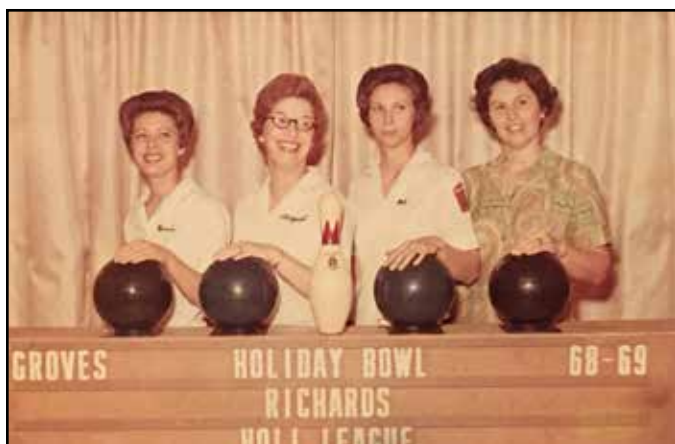
