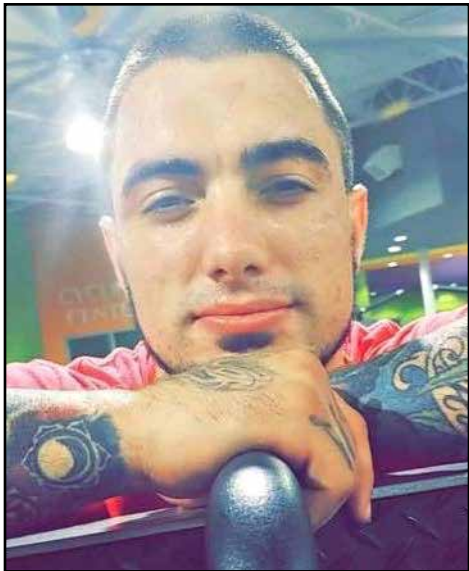

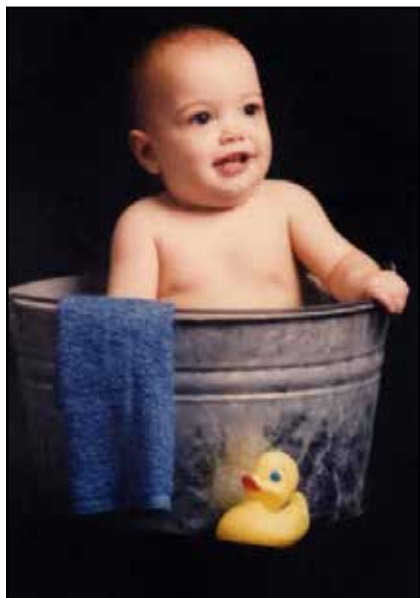


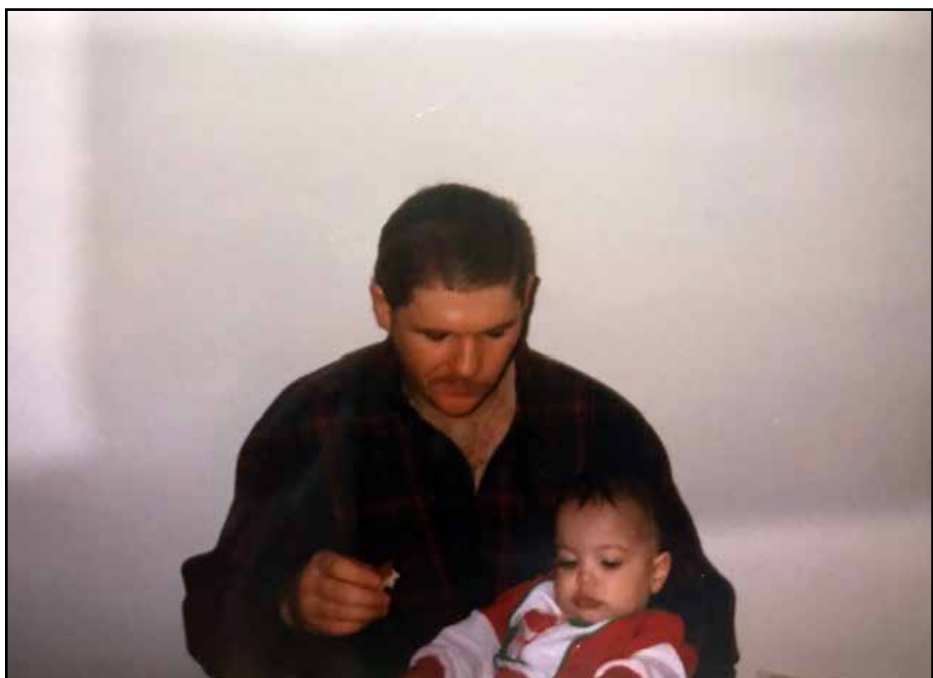

He is preceded in death by his grandparents, Delores Haynes McNulty and Earl and Betty Womack.

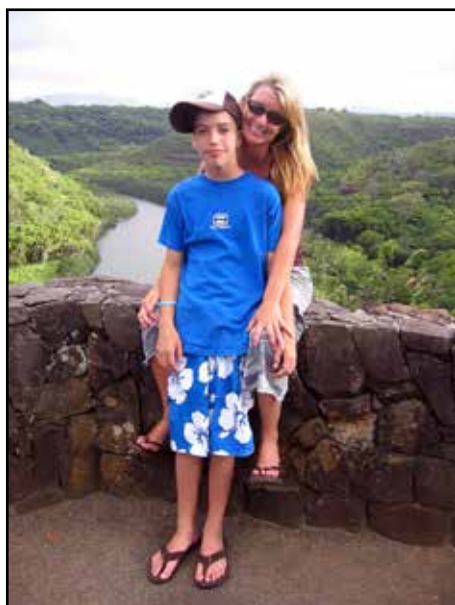
