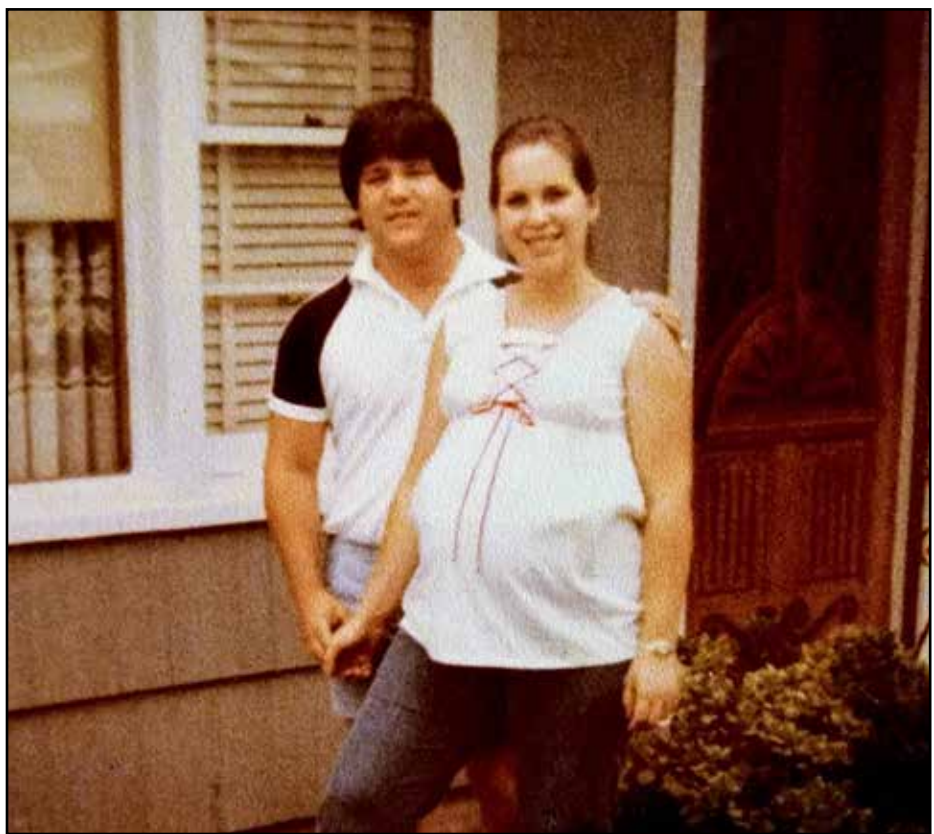

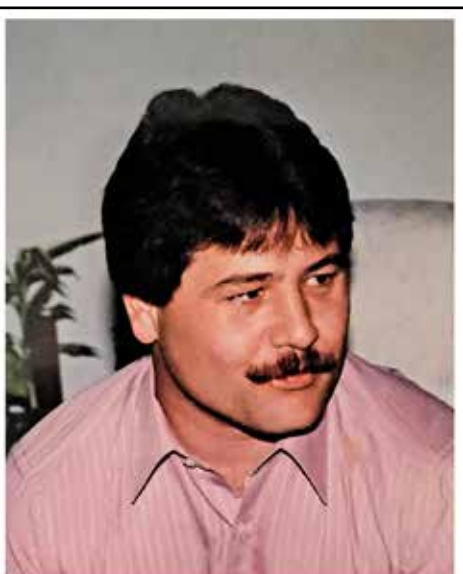
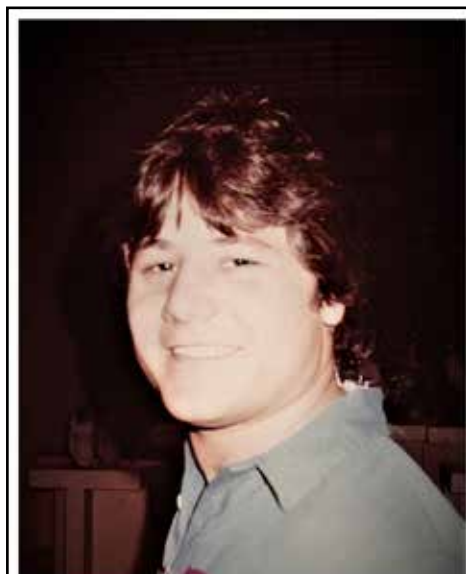
cooking. Most of all, he enjoyed spending time with his family.

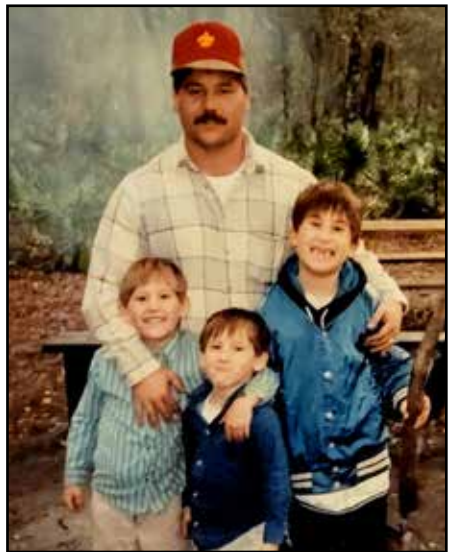
