She is preceded in death by her father, Raul Damers; grandfather, Blasé Padilla; and grandmother, Lucy Barela.







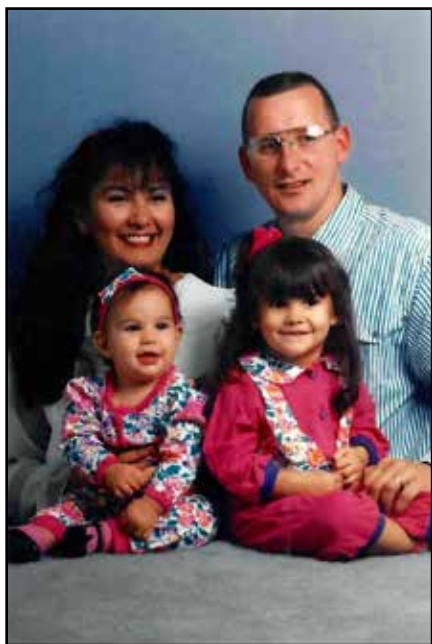




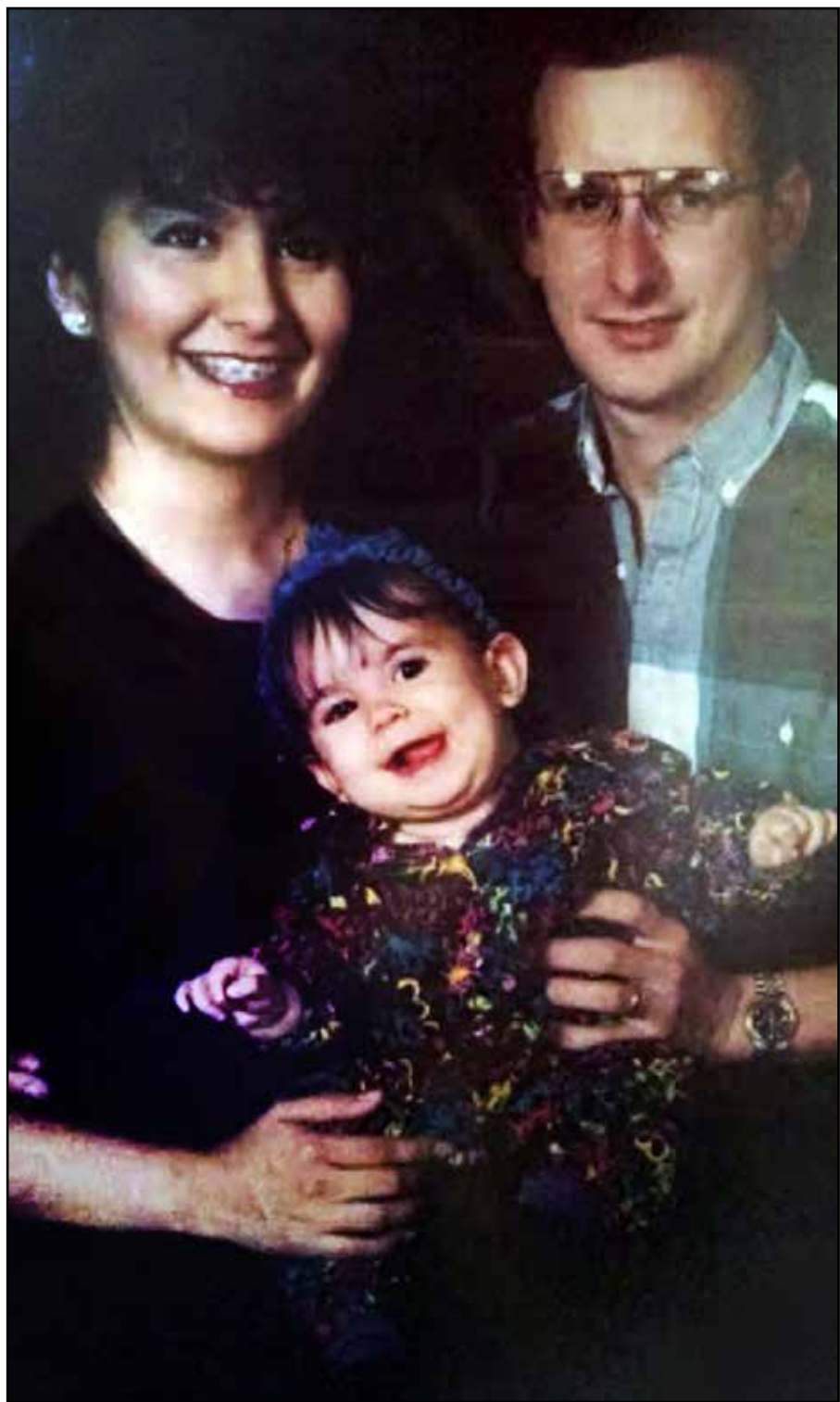
