August 13th, 2006, and then to their daughter, Danielle, on August 10th, 2008. Danny and Vickie were happily wed on December 27th, 2012.


He spent the remainder of his life as a model father, loving husband, and wonderful friend to everyone he came across.



He is preceded in death by his brother-in-law, Mark Richard.


