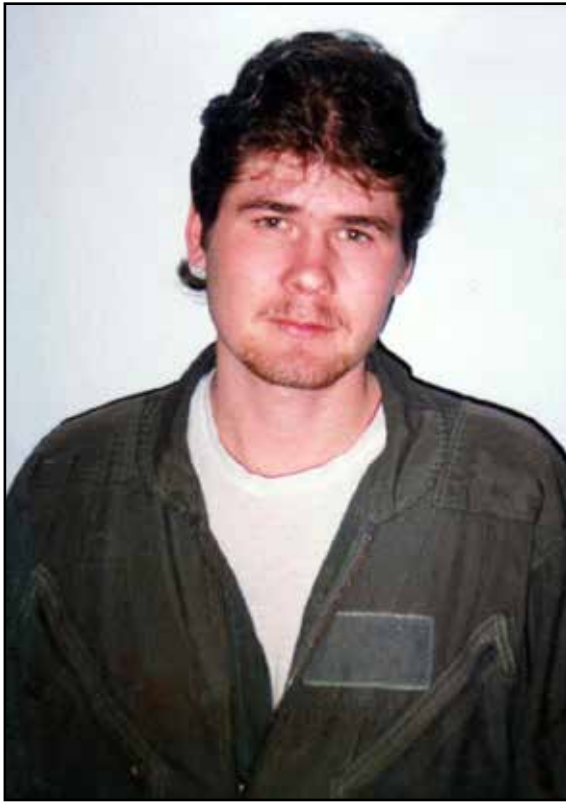

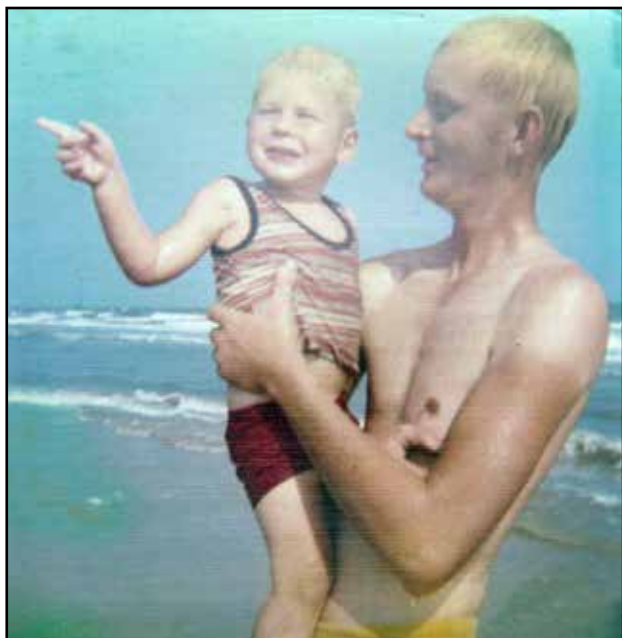

He is preceded in death by his parents, Georgia and Thomas Cameron; grandparents, Ida Mae Hodges, David Hoffpauir; and John Trahan.

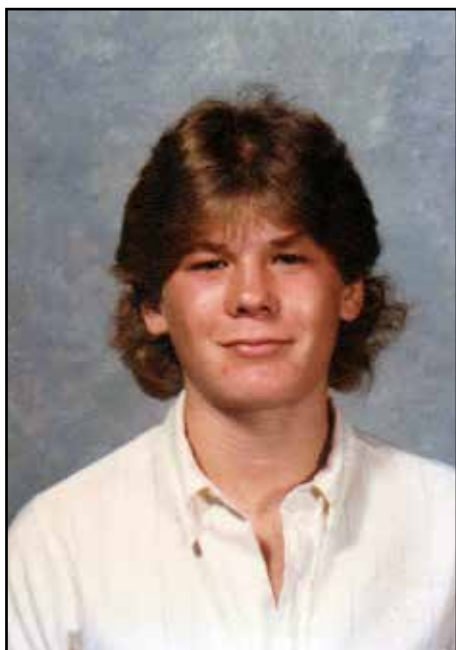
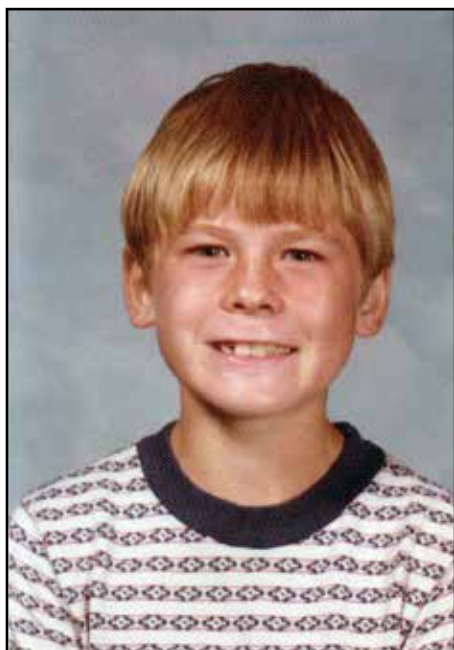






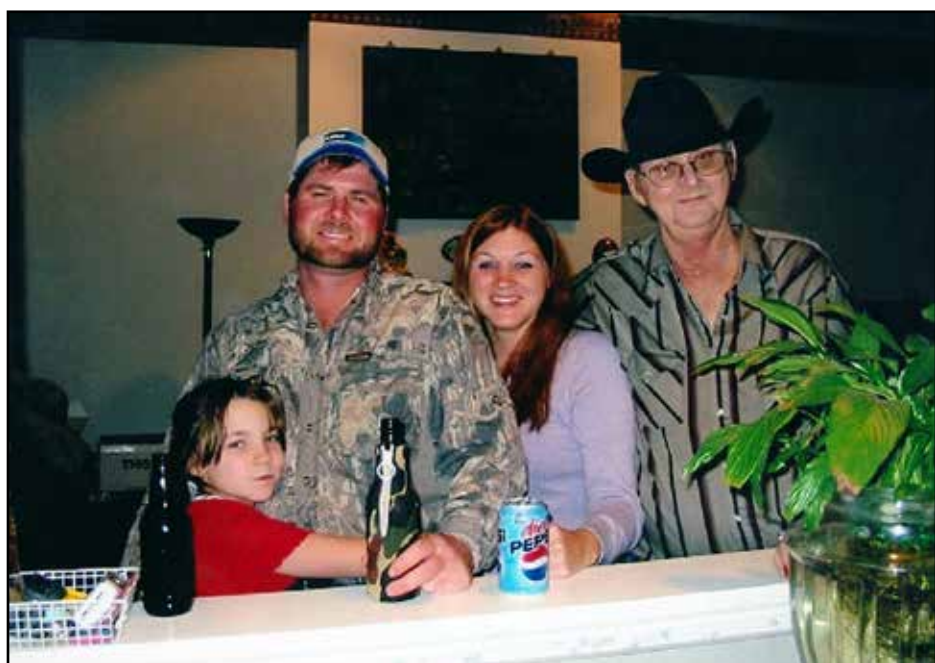
