He was preceded in death by his parents; wife, Rebecca Howard; and brother, Jay Eric Howard.





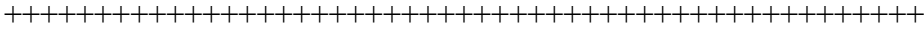




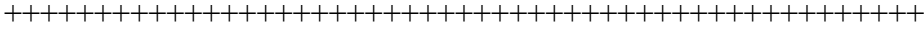
