Jonnie was an amazing wife, mother, sister, aunt, and friend.

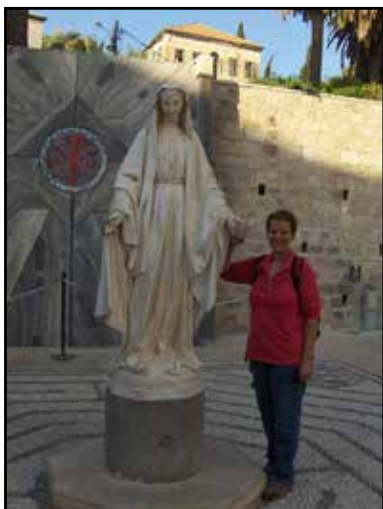

She is preceded in death by her parents and brother, Bill DuBose.



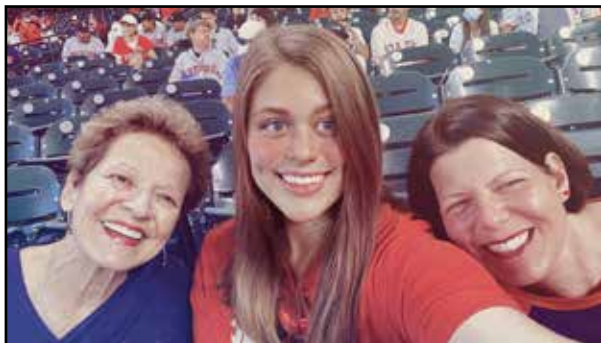
