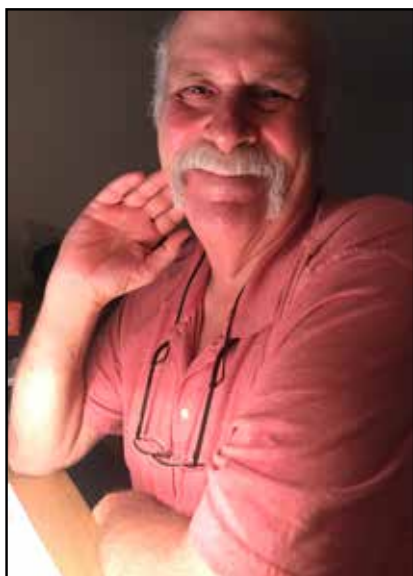

He was preceded in death by his father, Donald F. Pierson.



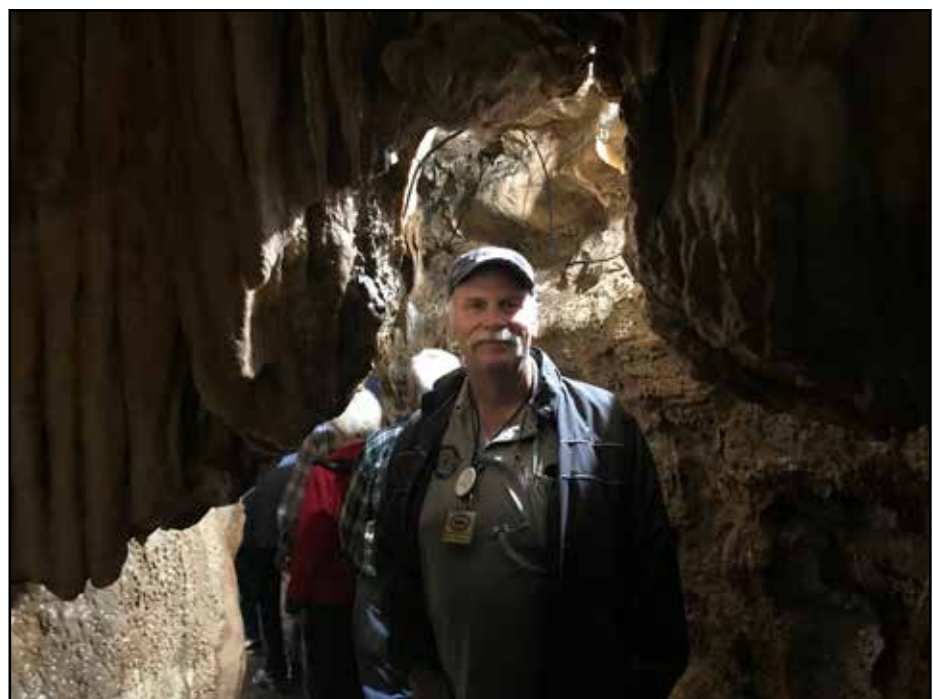
