Vaughan Edwyn Williams III, 78, died peacefully at his home in Nederland, Friday, March 11, 2022. He was born September 16, 1943, to Ruth and Vaughan Edwyn Williams, Jr., in Yonkers, New York. He attended Yorktown Heights High School where he graduated in 1962 and has continued to remain friends with his graduating class.

Upon graduation he entered the Air Force in with assignments to Lackland Air Force Base, TX; Keesler AFB, MS; Stewart AFB, NY; Clark AB, Philippines; Ramstein AB, Germany; Wiesbaden AB, Germany, and Blytheville AFB, AR. While stationed at Wiesbaden, he met Kathy.

They married soon after and spent 53 years together, to the day. He left active duty in 1969 and moved back to New York where he worked in the electronics industry.

In 1976, he moved his family to Texas where he was employed by the 273rd Engineering Installation Squadron in Nederland as an Engineering Supervisor. Throughout his career, his leadership and mentorship helped shape the lives and careers of many. He was loved and admired by his military family. Ed retired from the Air National Guard in 1999 as a Chief Master Sergeant. After retirement he pursued his love of cooking, genealogy, historical research, staying up on current events, and his dog, but most of all, his grandkids.

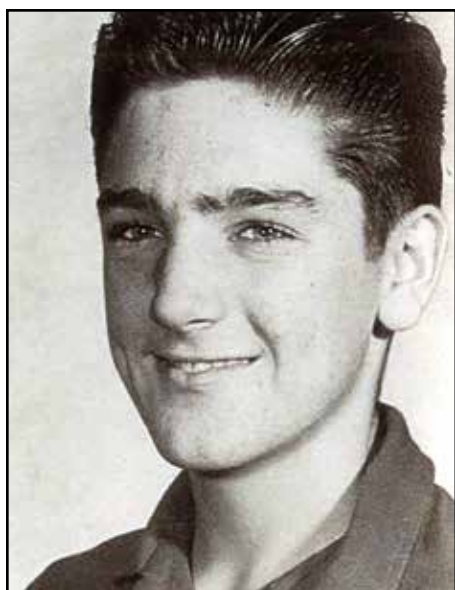

He is preceded in death by his parents and brother, Ricky Williams.





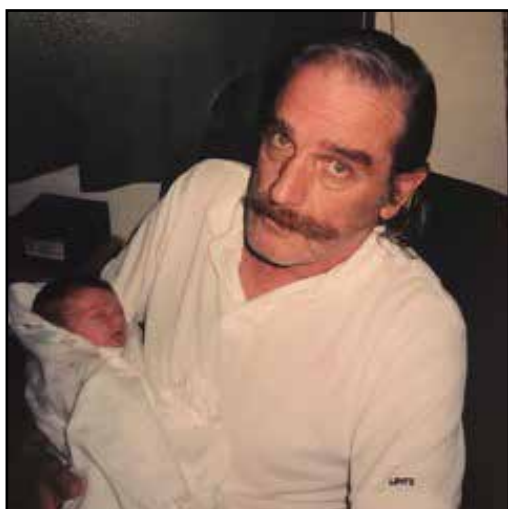
