where there are no days or years.*

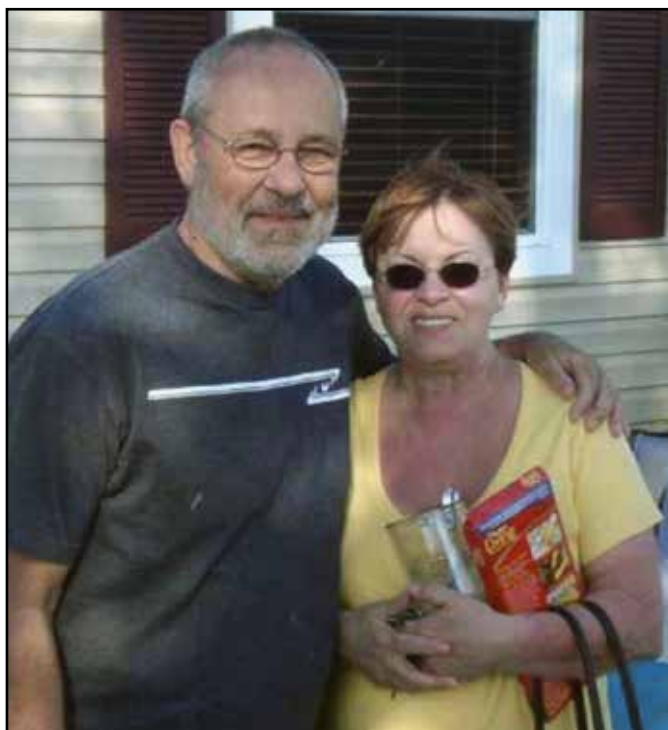
*Think how she must be wishing
