We will continue to celebrate the life that we had with Connor and to make sure he is never forgotten. We also hold to the hope, given by God, that we will one day be reunited with our son.

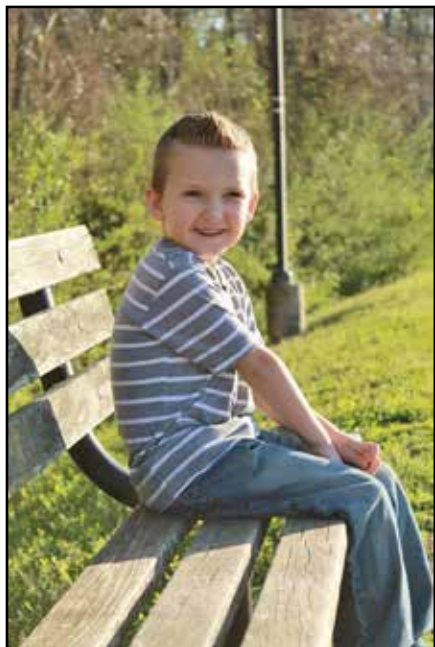
