She was preceded in death by their daughter, Cheryl; parents, Jake and Sara Angelo; and sister, Alice Horn.

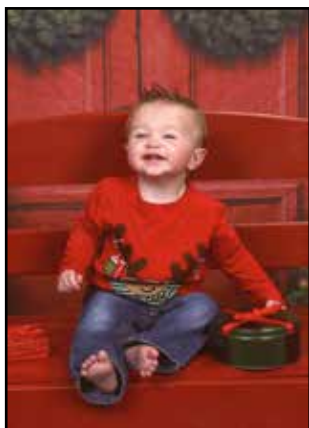








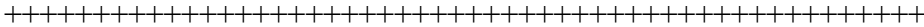




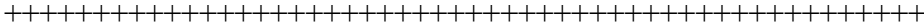
