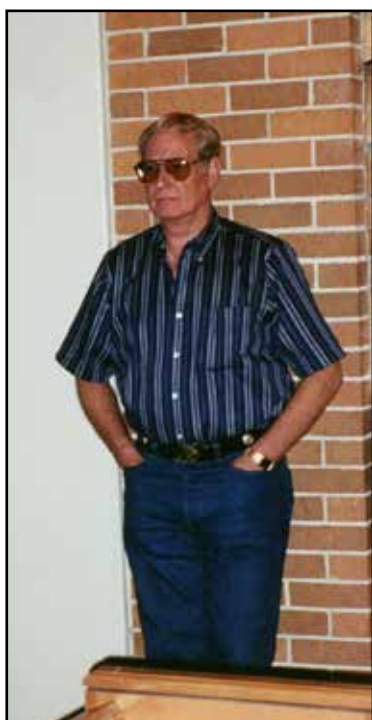
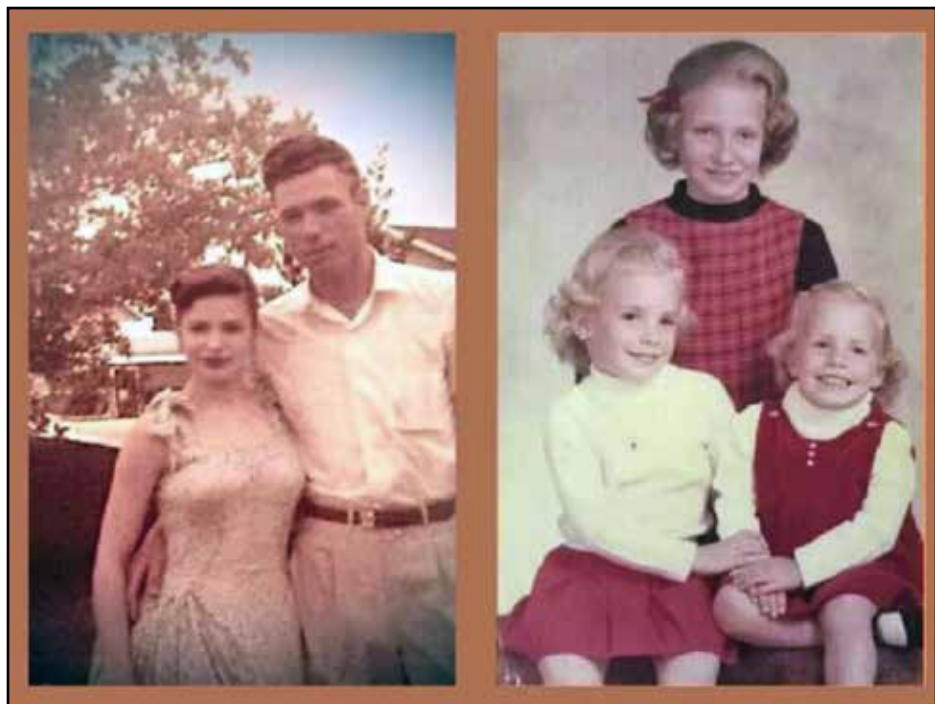
He is preceded in death by his parents; brothers, Doyle Chance and Kermit Chance; and late wife and mother of his children, Matilda Badeaux Chance.
