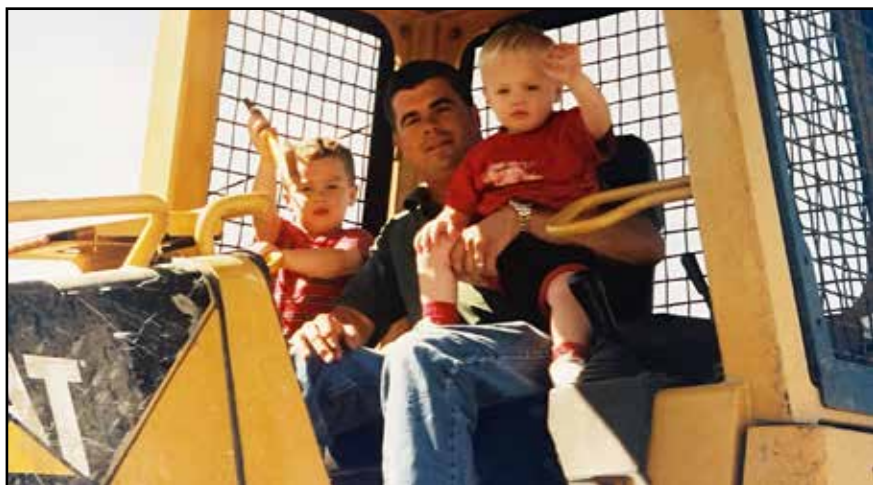

He is preceded in death by his nephew, Noah Rand.







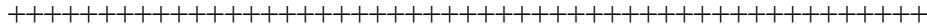




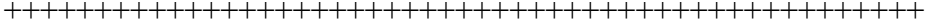
