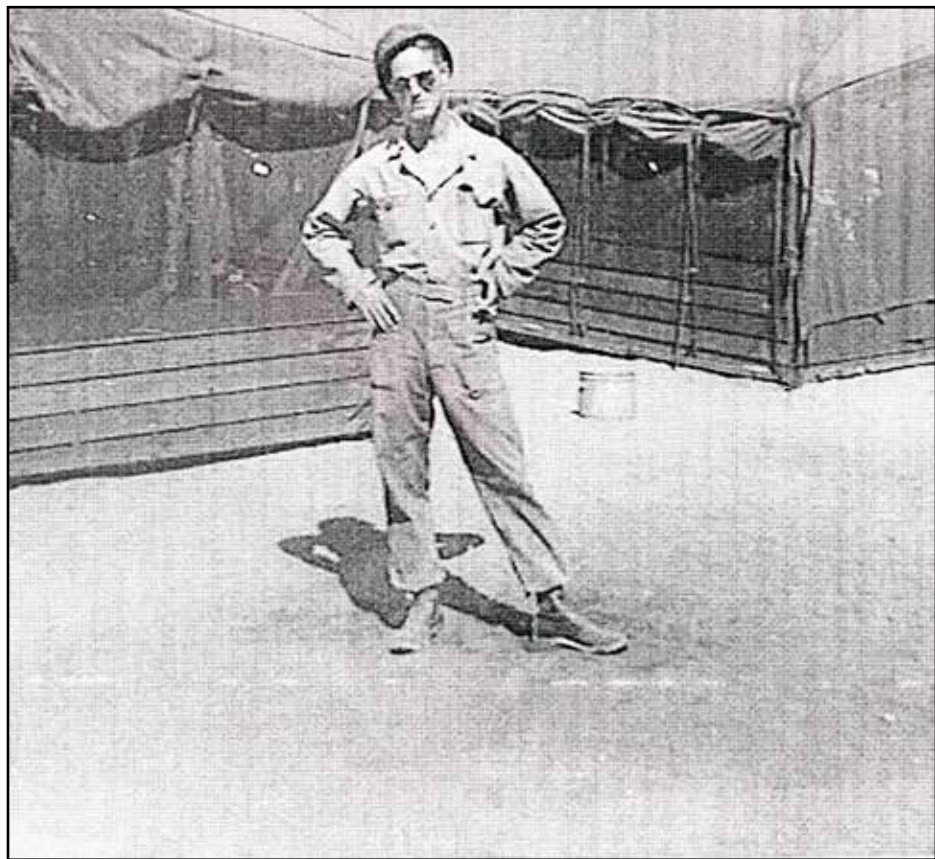

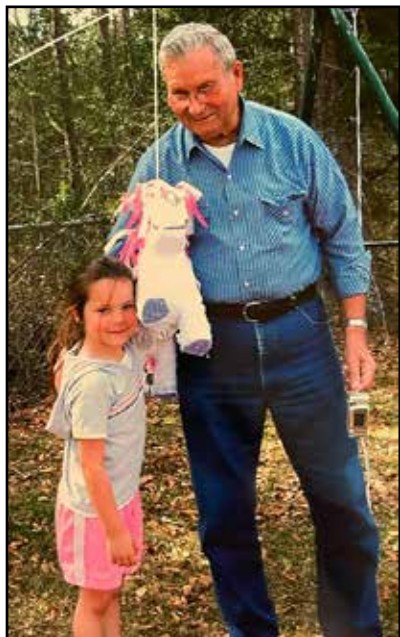


















I've Gone Fishin'
