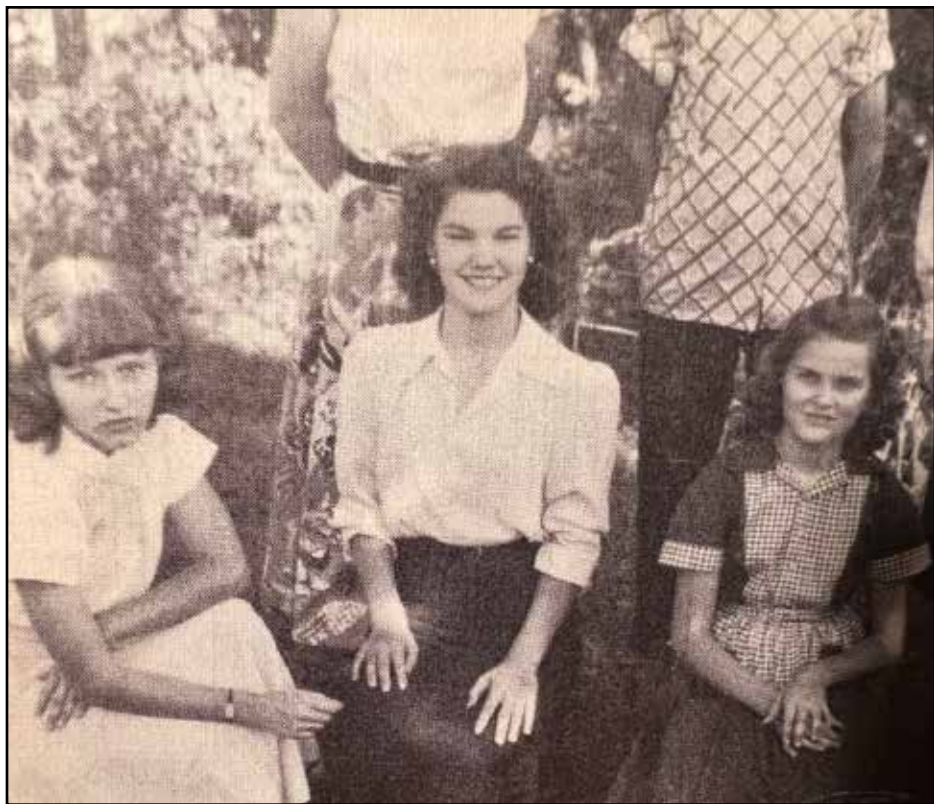
Patsy led an exemplary life and was an inspiration to many. She took great pride in always doing any job to the best of her ability and was never afraid to accept new challenges.
