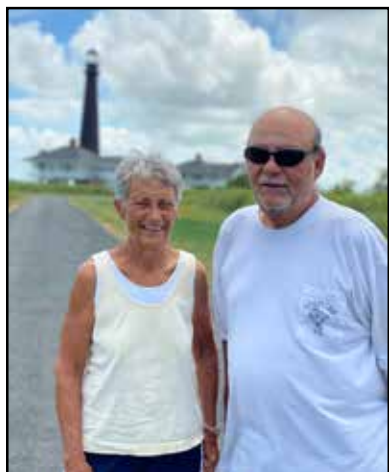




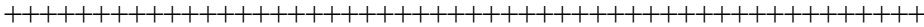


The Fisherman's Prayer

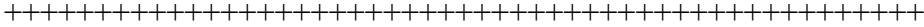
I pray that I may live to fish
