He was preceded in death by his parents; wife, Ada Jean McGhee LaSalle; and son, Jimmy Cobb.



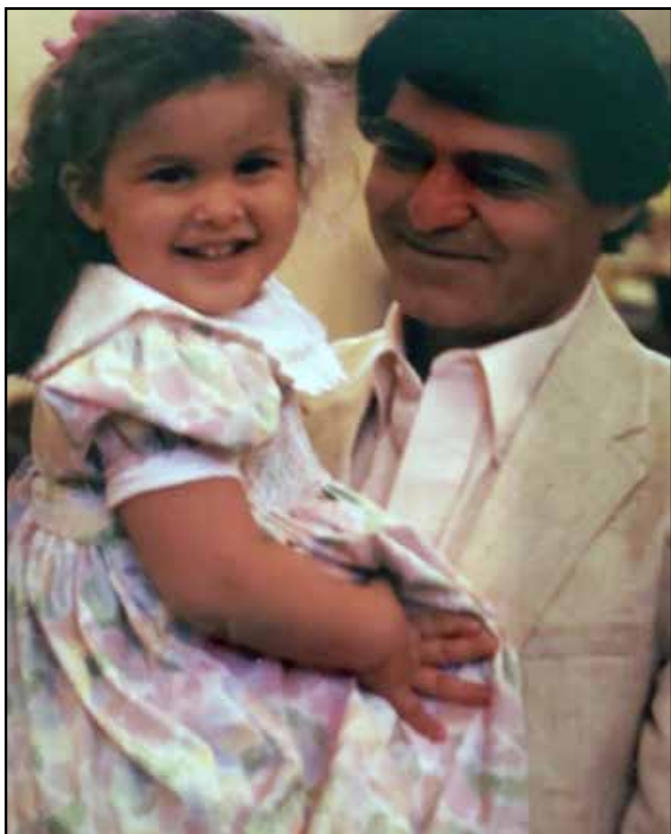






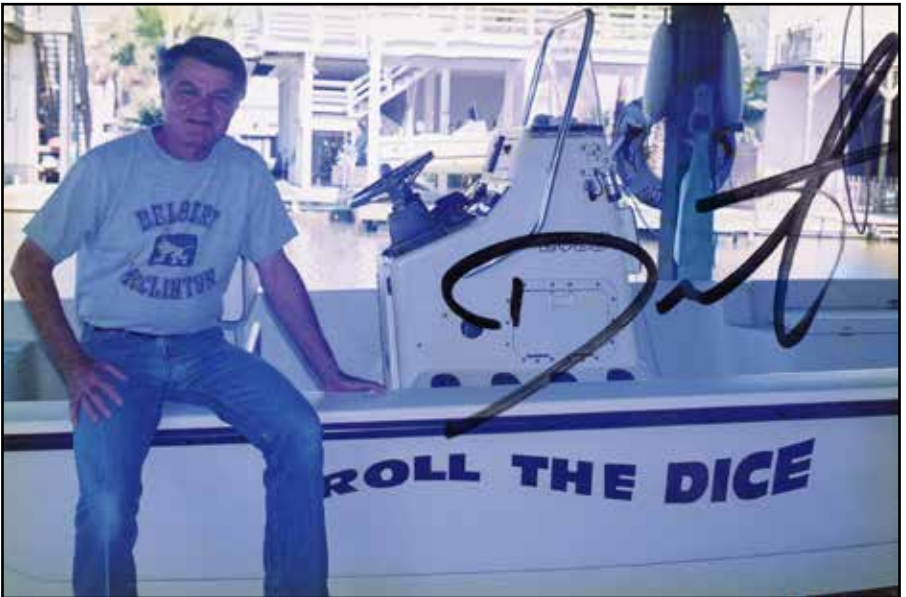


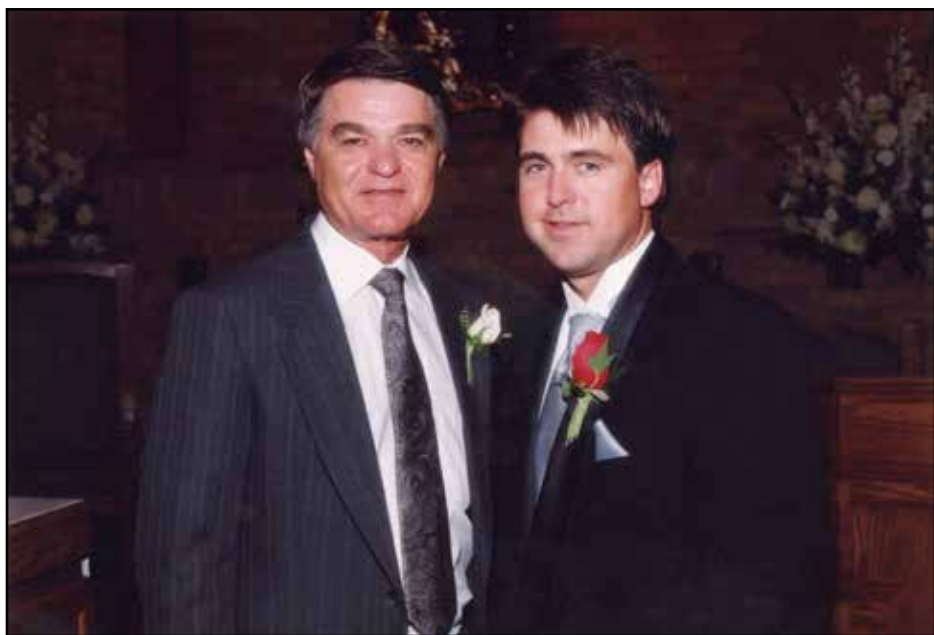














**ONE – EYED JOE**
