**Marline Calcote Toler**, 88, of Nederland, died Friday, November 4, 2022. She was born August 29, 1934, in Bunkie, Louisiana to Ada Mae and Foster Albert Calcote.

Marline's life mission was to spread the Word of Jesus. She ministered to others telling of the times she was healed by her faith and led a prayer group in her home for many years. She also provided Christian counseling on the crisis hotline for the Community Care Prayer Outreach Center.

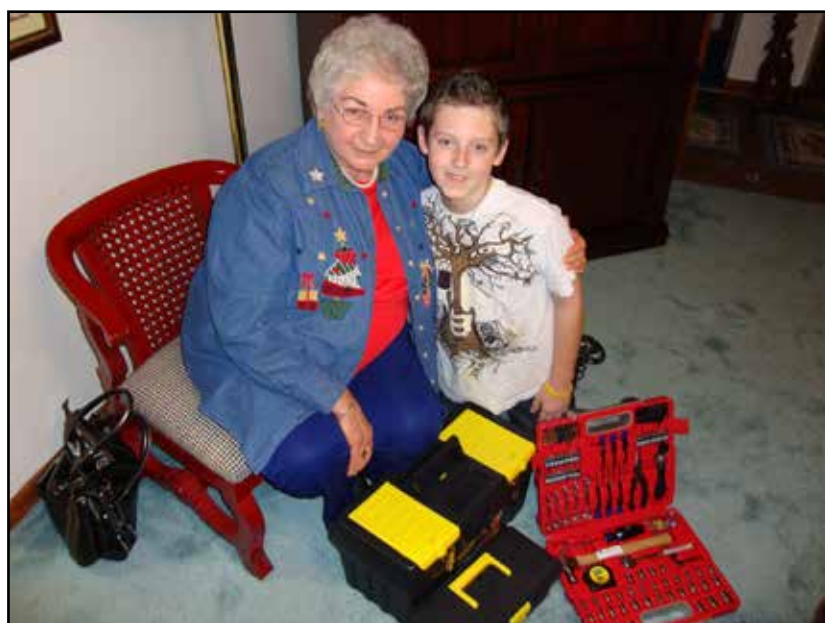
