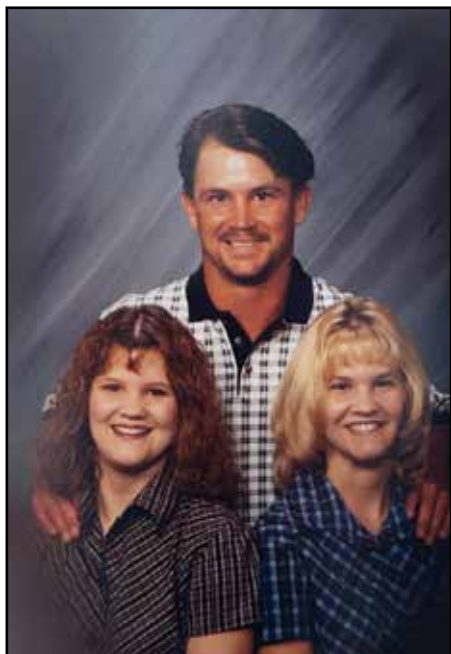
He will forever be remembered for his two-step moves, his great smile, and his ability to make the best of the cards that life dealt him.

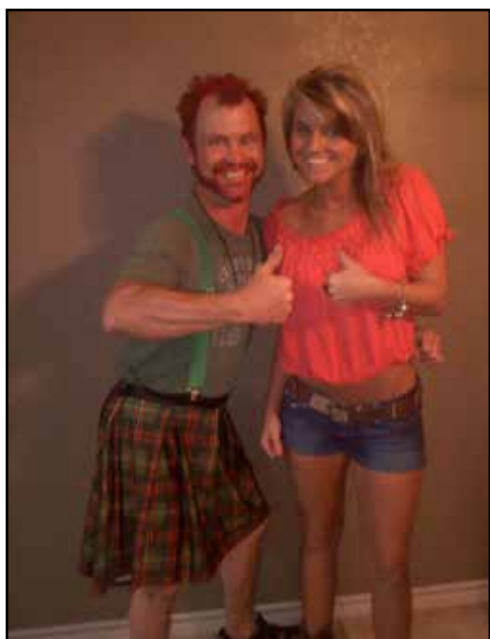
